Income historical review on CD-ROM

1980 to 1996

The *Income historical review* (1980-1996) on CD-ROM contains 42 cross-classified tables on income distributions and averages for families and individuals, the impact of transfer payments and income taxes, low-income rates for children and the elderly, and female-to-male earnings ratios. Some of the tables include never-before-published data, such as provincial income estimates for selected socio-demographic characteristics.

Included with the package is the user-friendly software, 'Beyond 20/20'. This data browser enables you to view and retrieve data in seconds, copy data to other popular Windows applications as well as analyse data patterns using graphics and maps.

Basic summary tabulations

1996 Census

This series from the 1996 Census provides summary information for small geographic areas of the country in tabulations using two or more inter-related census variables.

The entire series comprises 66 basic tabulations. Released today are four tabulations on education and eight tabulations on mobility and migration. Geographies include census divisions and subdivisions; census metropolitan areas, tracted census agglomerations and census tracts; federal electoral districts (1996 Representation Order); federal electoral districts (1987 Representation Order) and enumeration areas; and forward sortation areas. All geographies include data for Canada, provinces and territories.

Prices begin with a flat fee of \$60, plus \$1 for each of the first 100 geographic areas, and \$.05 for each additional area.

Radio and television statistics

1997

Revenues for privately-owned television stations increased 7.7% to \$1,703.3 million in 1997. Operational expenses represented 89.4% of total revenue compared with 92.9% in 1996. Net operating revenue before income taxes and other adjustments increased to 10.5% of revenue from 7.0% in 1996. Employees decreased to 7,801 in 1997 from 8,023 in 1996.

Revenues for privately-owned radio stations increased 7.5% to \$871.6 million in 1997. Operational expenses represented 93.3% of total revenue compared with 97.5% in 1996. Net operating revenue

before income taxes and other adjustments increased to 6.6% of revenue from 2.4% in 1996. Employees totalled 8,515 in 1997, virtually unchanged from 1996.
