Steel primary forms production totalled 1 406 296 metric tonnes in June, up 5.8% from 1 328 623 tonnes produced in June 1997.

Year-to-date production reached 8 254 053 tonnes, up 7.5% from 7 675 802 tonnes produced during the same period a year earlier.
