

Civil aviation operating statistics October 1999

In October, both Air Canada and Canadian Airlines reported a 6% increase in their domestic operations (seasonally adjusted passenger-kilometres). For Canadian Airlines, this follows substantial declines of 14% in September and 8% in August.

Low income cut-offs

1998

Before-tax low income cut-offs (LICOs) for 1998 are now available. Each year, the LICOs are updated to reflect cost of living increases, as indicated by the annual change in the Consumer Price Index.

Cut-offs are presented in the latest edition of *Low income cut-offs* (13-551-XIB, free) for 1980 to 1998. Both the 1992-base and 1986-base LICOs are contained in the report.

Although LICOs are often referred to as poverty lines, they have no official status as such, and Statistics Canada does not recommend their use for this purpose.
