Also included are the causes of death for 1996 and 1997.

### **Steel primary forms**

Week ending November 27, 1999 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending November 27, 1999 totalled 307 453 tonnes, up 1.4% from the week-earlier 303 202 tonnes and up 5.2% from the year-earlier 292 333 tonnes. The cumulative total at the end of the week was 14 584 473 tonnes, a 1.1% increase compared with 14 422 428 tonnes for the same period in 1998.

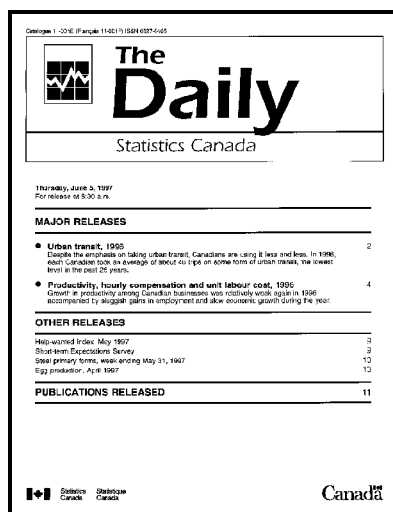
