### **Department store sales and stocks** April 1999

Department store sales rose 0.6% in April to \$1,455.5 million (seasonally adjusted). This increase followed consecutive declines in March (-0.6%) and February (-2.9%). April sales were 1.2% higher than in April 1998. Monthly department store sales, which were fairly flat throughout the spring and summer of 1998, have rebounded since the fall of 1998. The weakening sales in the spring and summer of 1998 occurred after a period of rising sales that began in early 1996.

Unadjusted for seasonality, department store sales at the national level grew 0.5% in April compared with April 1998. However, sales varied widely from one province to another. They declined 6.1% in the Atlantic provinces and 1.6% in the region which includes British Columbia, Yukon, the Northwest Territories and Nunavut. Manitoba registered the largest increase (+2.4%), followed by Quebec (+2.0%), Saskatchewan (+1.5%), Ontario (+1.3%) and Alberta (+0.5%).

## Asphalt roofing

April 1999

Production of asphalt shingles totalled 3 828 245 metric bundles in April, a 2.4% increase from 3 739 210 metric bundles produced in April 1998.

January to April 1999 production amounted to 12 909 753 metric bundles, a 2.0% decrease from 13 169 323 metric bundles (revised) produced during the same period in 1998.

# Electric power capability and load 1997

Total net generating capability of electric power in Canada increased 0.6% in 1997/98 to a new high of 107 616 megawatts. Electric power utilities predict a compound growth rate of 0.6% (or 6 415 megawatts) in net generating capability over the next ten years.
