Help-wanted Index

May 1999

The Help-wanted Index increased 0.9% in May to 157 (1996=100). Slight increases were observed in eight provinces while the indexes in British Columbia and Saskatchewan remained unchanged.

Note: The Help-wanted Index is compiled from the number of help-wanted ads published in 22 newspapers in 20 major metropolitan areas. The index is a measure of companies' intentions to hire new workers. This index has been seasonally adjusted and smoothed to ease month-to-month comparisons. The Help-wanted indexes series (seasonally adjusted, smoothed and trend cycle) have been revised from January 1996.

Short-term Expectations Survey

The results of the Short-term Expectations Survey show that the performance of the economy is expected to change little over the period from May to July compared with April, except for a very slight increase in inflation.

The month-over-month mean forecast for gross domestic product in March was 0.2% compared with the actual growth of 0.3%. Analysts expect a slight decrease in April and May, with a mean monthly growth of 0.2% for both months.

Forecasts for international trade show a small decrease from the March figure of \$2.6 billion. Average forecasts for exports show a slight increase from April to June with imports remaining unchanged.

Forecasters are expecting an increase in the Consumer Price Index over the May to July period. Actual inflation has been higher than expected — the average forecast for April was 1.1% compared with the actual rate of 1.7%.

The actual seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased to 8.3% in April, with the participation rate of 66.0% being higher than expected. Forecasters are anticipating a decrease of the unemployment rate to 8.1% in May and to 8.0% in both June and July. A slight decrease in the participation rate is expected for the May to July period, with rates of 65.9% for each of these three months.

Electronic publications pilot 1996/97: final report

May 1999

Available today is the final revised report of the *Electronic Publications Pilot 1996/97*. This publication offers data on how library staff and library users are adapting to the use of new technologies such as the Internet. The goal of this pilot project was to assess the impact of replacing print publications by electronic formats on the Internet — a change well underway at many libraries.

The pilot was conducted from September 1996 to September 1997 as a joint initiative of Statistics Canada and the Depository Services Program (DSP), in partnership with the depository library community. The DSP is the organization that provides official government publications to libraries for use by Canadians.


