## **Steel wire and specified wire products** May 1999

Shipments of steel wire and specified wire products totalled 73 333 tonnes in May, up 3.2% from 71 061 tonnes (revised) in May 1998. Production and export market data for selected commodities are also available.

#### Oils and fats

May 1999

Production of all types of deodorized oils in May totalled 93 311 tonnes, a 2.9% decrease from 96 080 tonnes in April. Year-to-date production for May 1999 was 468 716 tonnes, down 10.6% compared with 524 349 tonnes for the same period in 1998.

Domestic sales of deodorized margarine oil totalled 9 867 tonnes. Sales of deodorized shortening

oil were 30 807 tonnes while sales of deodorized salad oil amounted to 30 250 tonnes in May.


