Steel primary forms production for January totalled 1 450 433 tonnes, an increase of 16.0% from 1 250 651 tonnes in January 1999.

### Shipments of rolled steel

January 2000

Rolled steel shipments for January totalled 1 271 464 tonnes, up 10.3% from 1 152 638 tonnes in December 1999, and up 12.7% from 1 128 409 tonnes in January 1999.


