February 2000

Manufacturers shipped 562 610 tonnes of cement in February, up 13.4% from 495 967 tonnes in February 1999, and up 19.7% from a revised total of 470 074 tonnes in January 2000.

In January and February, shipments were 1 032 684 tonnes, up 14.0% from 905 636 tonnes shipped in the same two months of 1999.

February 2000

Steel pipe and tubing production in February totalled 239 704 tonnes, a 19.3% increase from 200 892 tonnes in February 1999.

Year-to-date production to the end of February 2000 was 475 052 tonnes, up 16.8% from 406 542 tonnes produced during the same period in 1999.
