### Steel primary forms

Week ending April 1, 2000 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending April 1 totalled 325 951 tonnes, down by 1.6% from 331 318 tonnes a week earlier but up 7.7% from 302 746 tonnes in the same week of 1999. The cumulative 2000 total for the year as of April 1 was 4 306 626 tonnes, 9.9% higher than the 3 917 191 tonnes produced in the same period of 1999.


