Steel primary forms

Week ending May 6, 2000 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending May 6 was 296 843 tonnes, up 4.8% from 283 300 tonnes a week earlier, but down 2.7% from 305 083 tonnes in the same week of 1999. The year-to-date total at the end of the reference week was 5 851 644 tonnes, a 7.1% increase compared with 5 461 377 tonnes in the same period of 1999.

Asphalt roofing

March 2000

Production of asphalt shingles totalled 4 379 826 metric bundles in March, a 26.4% increase from 3 465 967 metric bundles produced in March 1999.

Year-to-date production was 11 194 542 metric bundles, a 23.3% increase from 9 081 508 metric bundles produced during the same period in 1999.

Industrial chemicals and synthetic resins March 2000

Chemical firms produced 235 516 tonnes of polyethylene synthetic resins in March, an 11.3% increase from 211 618 tonnes in March 1999.

Year-to-date production at the end of March totalled 663 127 tonnes, up 10.7% from 599 071 tonnes (revised) in the same period a year earlier.

Data are also available on production of 3 other types of synthetic resins and 24 industrial chemicals.

Air charter statistics

Third quarter 1999 (preliminary)

Domestic charter flights carried 485,088 passengers, and international charter flights carried 1,245,836 passengers in the third quarter of 1999. This was a 10.0% advance for the domestic sector but a 0.4% decline for the international sector compared with the third quarter of 1998. In that period, domestic charters carried 440,304 passengers and international charters carried 1,250,491 passengers.


