### **Industrial chemicals and synthetic resins**

May 2000

Chemical firms produced 230 033 tonnes of polyethylene synthetic resins in May, an 8.2% increase from 212 619 tonnes in May 1999.

Year-to-date production at the end of May totalled 1 121 646 tonnes, up 10.4% from 1 015 778 tonnes produced a year earlier.

Data are also available on production of 3 other types of synthetic resins and 24 industrial chemicals.

Changes in the number of people taking urban transit. Canadians are riding it less and less. In 1996, each Canadian took an average of about six trips on some form of urban transit, the lowest level in the past 25 years.

Growth in productivity among Canadian businesses was relatively weak again in 1996, accompanied by sluggish gains in employment and slow moderate growth during the year.
