Domestic sales of refined petroleum products

May 2000 (preliminary)

Sales of refined petroleum products totalled 8 072 100 cubic metres, an increase of 6.7% from May 1999. Most of the increase is a result of a

greater number of business days in May 2000 than in May 1999.

Total motor gasoline sales were up 2.7% from the May 1999, however sales of mid-grades fell 28.9% and premium grades dropped 25.4%. Light fuel oil increased by 35.3 %, partly because of unusually cold temperatures in May. Heavy fuel oil advanced 9.5%.

Increased drilling activity in the oil and natural gas industry contributed to the 16.4% rise in diesel fuel sales.

Year-to-date sales of refined petroleum increased by 200 000 cubic metres or 0.5% over the same period in 1999. Sales increased for four of the seven major product groups; the largest advances were in diesel fuel

(+832 500 cubic metres or +9.7%) and other refined products (+308 000 cubic metres or +9.9%). The other refined products group includes asphalt, lube oils, stove oil and petroleum coke. Sales of heavy fuel oil fell 20.7%, and petrochemical feedstocks dropped 14.9%.

May 2000

Manufacturers shipped 1 229 498 tonnes of cement in May, up 2.7% from 1 196 737 (revised) tonnes in May 1999, and up 25.6% from 978 702 tonnes in April 2000.

From January to May, shipments totalled 4 041 244 tonnes, up 6.6% from 3 789 795 (revised) in the same period of 1999.


