

## CASH INCOME FROM THE SALE OF FARM PRODUCTS, 1960(1)

This report presents the regular annual preliminary estimate of cash income from the sale of farm products for the year 1960. As a result of more up-to-date information becoming available in recent weeks, this estimate for 1960 differs slightly from the advance preliminary report published in January. In addition to the 1960 estimates, this report contains revised figures for 1958 and 1959 (2) and the commodity detail for each of the three years.

The present estimate indicates that during the year 1960 Canadian farmers received 2,783.0 million dollars from the sale of farm products, participation payments on previous years' grain crops, net cash advances on farm-stored grains, and deficiency payments made under the present farm prices support program. This is only fractionally below the advance preliminary estimate for 1960 of 2,783.8 million dollars, and less than one per cent below the revised figure of 2,789.3 million for 1959.

On a commodity basis, the more important reductions in farm cash income during 1960, relative to 1959, were recorded for barley, flaxseed and hogs. On the other hand the more important gains were realized from the sale of wheat, potatoes, fruits, vegetables, tobacco, cattle and dairy products, and from a substantial increase in cash advances on farm-stored grains in western Canada.

In addition to the above cash returns, farmers in the Prairie Provinces also received in 1960 about 77 million dollars paid out under the provisions of the Prairie Farm Assistance Act, the Western Grain Producers' Acreage Payment Plan and the Federal-Provincial Emergency Unthreshed Grain Assistance Policy. This is in contrast to a year earlier when farmers received approximately 22 million dollars, most of which was received under the provisions of the Prairie Farm Assistance Act. When these payments are added to the cash returns from sales, cash advances on farm-stored grains, and participation and deficiency payments, total cash returns to farmers from their farming operations amounted to 2,860.2 million dollars as compared with 2,811.4 million dollars in 1959.

Field Crops - Farmers' cash returns from the sale of field crops, estimated at 1,056.4 million dollars for 1960, were slightly more than three per cent above the revised estimate of 1,023.5 million dollars for 1959. Contributing most to this gain was higher income for the sale of wheat, potatoes, vegetables, fruits, tobacco and a substantial increase in cash advances on farm-stored grains in western Canada. A somewhat smaller contribution was made by oats. In the case of wheat and oats, higher marketings more than offset slightly lower average prices. Higher income from the sale of potatoes resulted from increased marketings and a substantial gain in average prices. A record crop of tobacco in Ontario was reflected in the higher returns to farmers from this crop.

Partially offsetting the increase in income from the above commodities was a significant drop in returns from the sale of barley resulting entirely from reduced marketings. More moderate declines were noted for flaxseed, and rye as well as for the participation payments made by the Canadian Wheat Board.

Returns from field crops were higher in all provinces except Nova Scotia, Manitoba and Alberta. These increases ranged all the way from just over one per cent in Saskatchewan to 22 per cent in Prince Edward Island and 35 per cent in New Brunswick. The substantial gains in the two Maritime provinces were attributable for the most part to increased returns from potatoes. Provincial reductions in income from field crops varied from about two per cent in Manitoba to nearly five per cent in Nova Scotia.

Livestock and Livestock Products - Estimated at 1,681.5 million dollars, farmers' income from the sale of livestock and livestock products during 1960 was about two and a half per cent below the 1959 level of 1,726.5 million dollars. The decline was due entirely to reduced returns from the sale of hogs, poultry and eggs. In the case of hogs, the average price for the year 1960 was virtually unchanged from that of the previous year, but marketings were down substantially. Egg prices averaged slightly higher in 1960 than in 1959, but marketings were smaller. Production of poultry meat in 1960 declined more than enough to offset fractionally higher prices for fowl and chickens and substantially higher prices for turkeys.

Returns from cattle and calves in 1960 were estimated at 561.4 million dollars, nearly 10 million dollars more than in 1959; although average prices were below the 1959 levels, marketings were up. Prices of dairy products were down slightly, but production was up sufficiently to provide a total cash income from this item of 518.9 million dollars as against 514.2 million for 1959.

Farmers' returns from the sale of livestock and livestock products were down in all provinces except Nova Scotia and Alberta. In Alberta returns were practically unchanged whereas in Nova Scotia they increased by just over two per cent. The declines recorded for the remaining provinces ranged all the way from less than one per cent in British Columbia to nearly 13 per cent in Saskatchewan.

The estimates contained herein are based on reports of marketings and prices received by farmers for principal farm products and are subject to revision as more complete data become available. The estimates include the amounts paid by the Canadian Wheat Board in the form of participation payments. They also include deficiency payments made under the present farm prices support program and net cash advances on farm-stored grains. Payments made under the provisions of the Prairie Farm Assistance Act, the Western Grain Producers' Acreage Payment Plan and the Federal-Provincial Emergency Unthreshed Grain Assistance Policy are not included with cash income from the sale of farm products but are included in total cash income in the year in which payments were made, being classified as "Supplementary Payments".

In Table I overleaf is summarized the preliminary estimate of cash income from the sale of farm products, by quarters and by provinces, for the calendar year 1960 and revised estimates for 1958 and 1959. Tables 2, 3 and 4 present farm cash income by commodity sources for each province, except Newfoundland, for each of the three years and also supplementary payments. No information is available for Newfoundland.
