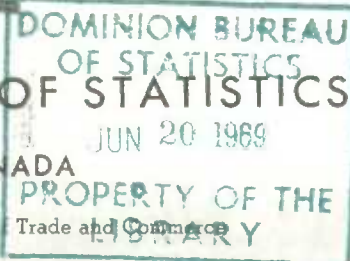

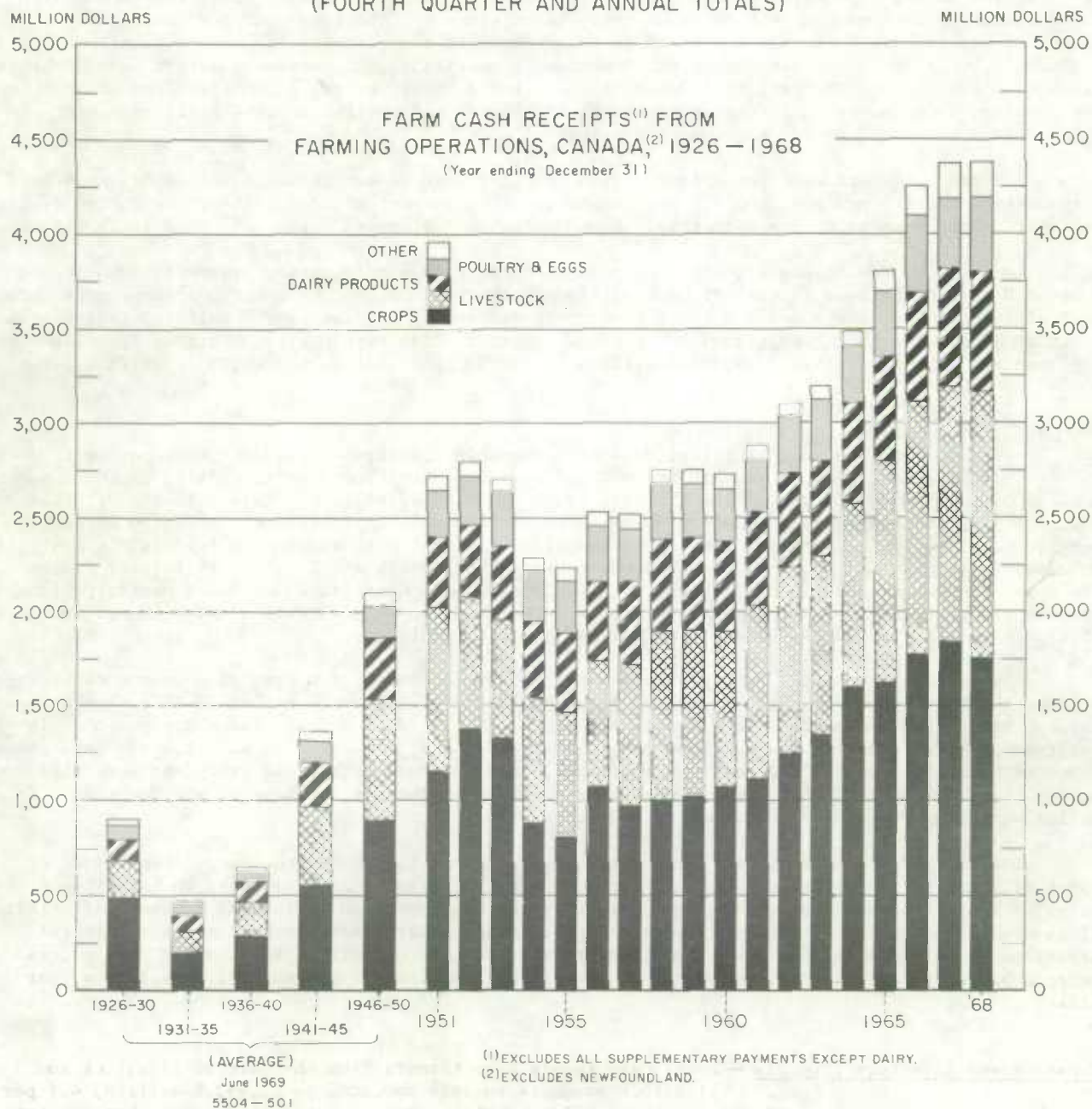

FARM CASH RECEIPTS, 1968(1)

This report presents, by commodity and by province, estimates of farm cash receipts from farming operations for the calendar year 1968, and revised estimates for the years 1960 to 1967. (See below). As a result of more up-to-date information becoming available in recent weeks, the provincial and Canada totals contained herein for 1968 differ slightly from those presented in the preliminary report published in April. Included in this report are cash receipts from the sale of farm products, Canadian Wheat Board participation payments on previous years' grain crops, net cash advances on farm-stored grains in Western Canada, deficiency payments made by the Agricultural Stabilization Board and supplementary payments outlined below. No deductions have been made for the cost of production of commodities sold. Estimates of expenses involved in farming operations together with total farm income are published annually in the DBS publication "Farm Net Income" (Catalogue no. 21-202).

Total cash receipts from farming operations for 1968, excluding supplementary payments, are now estimated at \$4,385.4 million for Canada. This estimate is fractionally above the record high of \$4,379.7 million in 1967 and 14.6 per cent above the average for the five-year period 1963-67. Maintenance of cash receipts at this level can be attributed for the most part to higher total returns from cattle, dairy products (including supplementary payments), eggs, potatoes, larger cash advances on farm-stored grains, and greater total Canadian Wheat Board participation payments. Lower cash returns were realized from the sale of tobacco and western oilseeds and smaller total initial receipts obtained from wheat and barley at time of delivery.

Increases in farm cash receipts occurred in all provinces except Manitoba and Saskatchewan where declines of 1.4 per cent and 7.7 per cent respectively were recorded. The gains in the remaining provinces ranged from about one per cent in Nova Scotia to just over 5 per cent in British Columbia.

In addition to the above income, farmers also received supplementary payments amounting to about \$8.0 million in 1968 as against \$6.1 million in 1967. These payments include those made under the Prairie Farm Assistance Act and other government assistance to farmers who suffered losses as a result of adverse weather conditions. When added together, cash receipts from farming operations and supplementary payments totalled \$4,393.3 million in 1968 slightly above the \$4,385.8 million realized in 1967.

Field Crops — In 1968, farmers' total returns from the sale of field crops, cash advances on farm-stored grains in Western Canada, and Canadian Wheat Board participation payments amounted to \$1,755.5 million, 5 per cent below the 1967 level of \$1,849.7 million. This estimate of field crop receipts for 1968 represents about 40 per cent of farmers' total cash receipts from farming operations, slightly less than in 1967. The reduction in total cash returns in 1968 is due mostly to decreased total returns from the sale of tobacco, western oilseeds and lower total initial receipts from wheat and barley at time of delivery. On the other hand, Canadian Wheat Board participation payments and cash advances on farm-stored grains in Western Canada were well above year-ago levels and total cash receipts to potato producers displayed a substantial gain.

The decline in initial receipts from wheat and barley reflects a reduction in the marketings of these two grains between 1967 and 1968. Although average prices were higher in 1968 than a year earlier, the increase was not sufficient to offset the smaller deliveries. The sharp cut-back in cash receipts from flaxseed stems directly from a 42.8 per cent reduction in marketings. As a consequence of both lower prices and smaller marketings, cash returns to rapeseed producers were also down sharply. A reduction of nearly 10 per cent in receipts from the sale of tobacco was due mostly to smaller marketings of flue-cured tobacco in Ontario.

During 1968, Canadian Wheat Board participation payments reached the record high level of \$359.6 million; in 1967 these payments amounted to \$311.8 million. Cash advances on farm-stored grains in Western Canada also reached a record level of \$52.6 million in 1968 as a result of a fall-off in demand and consequent lack of elevator space to accommodate farmers' deliveries. Farmers' marketings of potatoes in 1968 did not differ greatly from the quantities sold in 1967 but prices averaged higher to give a total estimated income of \$64.7 million as against \$53.1 million a year earlier.

Livestock and Livestock Products — Total cash receipts to farmers from the sale of livestock and livestock products in 1968 amounted to \$2,492.8 million, 4.1 per cent above the 1967 level of \$2,394.3 million. Contributing most to this gain were higher receipts

from the sale of cattle, eggs and dairy products. In 1968, greater numbers of cattle were marketed at average prices not greatly different than those of 1967. Both sales and prices of eggs were higher in 1968 than in 1967. The increase in total receipts from dairy products, from \$625.1 million in 1967 to \$643.0 million in 1968, is almost entirely attributable to higher prices. In addition to these returns, dairy producers also received \$109.7 million in the form of supplementary payments from the Canadian Dairy Commission as against \$103.2 million in 1967. Total cash receipts to hog producers in 1968 remained close to 1967 levels as a result of little change in either total marketings or average prices. For the most part, higher prices contributed to the increase in total cash receipts realized from the sale of poultry meat; production of turkey meat was down, while that of chicken and broilers was up.

Revisions of Estimates of Farm Cash Receipts 1960-67

Estimates of farm cash receipts from farming operations have now been revised for the years 1960 to 1967 inclusive to include bench-mark data obtained from the 1966 Census of Agriculture and the most up-to-date information from private and Government sources. The results of these revisions are set forth by commodity and by province for these years in this report. The extent of these revisions was not great. For Canada as a whole they amounted to less than one per cent while on a provincial basis they did not exceed two per cent.

Estimates of cash receipts from farming operations include the returns from all sales of agricultural products except those associated with direct inter-farm transfers. The prices used to value all products sold are prices to farmers at the farm level; they include any subsidies, bonuses and premiums which can be attributed to specific products, but they exclude any storage, transportation, processing and handling charges which are not actually received by farmers.

Many sources of information are used in the preparation of these estimates. These include the Censuses of Agriculture; periodic Bureau surveys of production and disposition of crops, livestock and animal products; farm product marketing agencies; processors of agricultural products; Bureau surveys of prices received by farmers in connection with agricultural activities; agricultural statistics arising out of administrative responsibilities of various government departments, both Federal and Provincial.
