CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JANUARY 10, 1930.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending January 10, 1930, show a net decrease of 2,365,424 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 227,032,671; Oats 21,778,060; Barley 29,603,835; Flax 1,224,678; Rye 8,541,446, a total of 288,180,590 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 2,120,371; Oats 170,233 and Rye 197,573 bushels, while Barley and Flax show increases of 20,035 and 2,718 bushels respectively.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Stocks of grain at these elevators show a net increase of 117,037 bushels. Wheat and Flax show increases of 202,405 and 5,274 bushels, while decreases are noted in Oats of 54,451; Barley 34,595 and Rye 1,596 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on January 3, 1930, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1929.


INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY).- Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 107,725 bushels. Wheat and flax show decreases of 129,637 and 2,208 bushels respectively, while Oats and Barley show increases of 18,326 and 5,794 bushels respectively.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 593,180 bushels. Wheat and Barley show decreases of 608,532 and 993 bushels respectively, while Oats show an increase of 16,345 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at this elevator show an increase of 3,208 bush.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR.- Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for the previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net increase of 1,051,309 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 855,464, Barley 166,321, Flax 9,380 and Rye 50,084 bushels, while Oats show a decrease of 29,940 bushels.


