CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING APRIL 11, 1930.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending April 11, show a net decrease of 3,926,674 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 191,155,238; Oats 15,568,290; Barley 25,675,408; Flax 929,316, and Rye 8,619,850, a total of 241,948,102 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 2,877,304; Oats 685,868; Barley 328,054 and Flax 46,418 bushels, while Rye shows an increase of 10,970 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a decrease of 2,116,317 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 1,365,000; Oats 487,505; Barley 192,367; Flax 37,577 and Rye 33,868 bushels.
