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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING MAY 16th, 1930.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending May 16th, show a net decrease of 585,600 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 164,191,290, Oats 12,336,532, Barley 24,067,337, Flax 743,027 and Rye 8,555,735 bushels, a total of 209,893,921 bushels. Wheat and Oats show decreases of 6,277,186 and 299,111 bushels respectively, while increases are noted in Barley of 367,703, Flax 35,703 and Rye 316,871 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Stocks of grain in store at these elevators show a decrease of 2,244,007 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 1,689,047, Oats 293,559, Barley 211,835, Flax 23,012 and Rye 26,554 bushels.
