Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending December 12th, show a net increase of 3,872,377 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 214,784,221, Oats 14,397,758, Barley 31,622,678, Flax 2,182,123 and Rye 13,307,102 bushels, a total of 276,299,822 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 4,233,507, Oats 75,458 and Rye 200,991 bushels, while Barley and Flax show decreases of 550,399 and 80,180 bushels respectively. For the same week last year the amount in store was 290,861,233 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 229,556,001, Oats 22,003,014, Barley 29,476,732, Flax 1,150,855 and Rye 8,674,631 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS: - Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a net increase of 552,632 bushels. Wheat shows an increase of 322,516 bushels, while decreases are noted in Oats of 104,704, Barley 70,804, Flax 86,625 and Rye 7,751 bushels.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). - Stocks for the week show a decrease of 141,059 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 120,749, Oats 18,384 and Barley 1,926 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 1,300,016 bushels. Wheat and Oats show increases of 1,265,038 and 36,385 bushels respectively, while decreases are noted in Barley of 1,257 and Rye 200 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR. - Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for the previous week.

VICTORIA ELEVATORS. - Wheat stocks at this elevator show an increase of 35,337 bushels.
