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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 13, 1931.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending February 13, show a decrease of 5,288,416 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 195,071,689, Oats 13,479,719, Barley 30,003,254, Flax 2,135,958 and Rye 13,316,275 bushels, a total of 254,006,895 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 5,440,610, Oats 399,753, Barley 363,364, Flax 6,705 and Rye 77,984 bushels. For the same week last year the amount in store was 272,867,773 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 214,491,447, Oats 19,844,741, Barley 28,743,578, Flax 1,138,640 and Rye 8,649,357 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. - Stocks of grain in store at these elevators show a decrease of 1,990,539 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 1,660,867, Oats 125,944, Barley 118,260, Flax 43,156 and Rye 42,342 bushels.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). - Stocks for the week show a decrease of 512,067 bushels made up of the following: Wheat 505,943, Oats 868 and Barley 5,256 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 4,454 bushels, Oats and Rye show decreases of 17,356 and 7,400 bushels, respectively, while Wheat shows an increase of 20,302 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS. - Wheat stocks at this elevator show an increase of 1,339 bushels.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR. - Stocks at this elevator show an increase of 95,809 bushels, made up of the following: Wheat 95,725 and Oats 84 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR). - Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net increase of 818,142 bushels. Wheat shows an increase of 770,504, Flax 36,445 and Rye 18,518 bushels, while Oats and Barley show decreases of 1,566 and 5,759 bushels respectively.
