CANADIAN WHEAT MOVEMENT

During the week ended August 7, 1931, according to elevator reports from Canadian Seaboard ports, 1,531,247 bushels of Canadian wheat were shipped by vessel overseas. The clearances of Canadian wheat from United States Atlantic Seaboard ports amounted to 649,000 bushels, making a total export clearance for the week of 2,230,247 bushels.

Wheat stocks show a decrease compared with the previous week ended July 31, 1931. The quantity in store on August 7, 1931, was 107,855,936 bushels, compared with 111,306,858 bushels for the week ended July 31, 1931, while 96,947,169 bushels were in store for the week ended August 8, 1930.

Of the total quantity of wheat in store on August 7, 5,354,306 bushels are in elevators at the United States Lake and Atlantic Seaboard ports, of which 3,979,114 bushels are in store and afloat at Buffalo, New York.

The western country elevator shipments for the week ended July 31, 1931, amounted to 1,610,056 bushels, compared with 1,947,440 bushels for the previous week. For the crop year ended July 31, 1931, wheat delivered at the country elevators and over the loading platforms was 307,146,626 bushels or 69,093,974 bushels more than the total of 238,047,652 bushels for the crop year 1930.

For the week ended August 7, 1931, 924 cars of wheat were inspected compared with 1,288 cars for the same week last year. Of the 1,288 cars inspected 255 cars or 17.9 per cent graded tough and damp and 571 cars or 61.7 per cent were placed in the contract grades.


During the crop year ended July 31, 208,897 cars of wheat were inspected, of which 139,741 cars or 66.39 per cent graded No. 3 Northern and better. This compares with 159,942 cars inspected for the crop year 1930, 140,157 cars or 87.62 per cent grading within the contract grades.

The movement of wheat by vessel from the Head of the Lakes during the week ended July 31, 1931, amounted to 3,218,279 bushels, the distribution of which was as follows:- To Buffalo, 1,936,256 bushels; To Canadian Lower Lake Ports, 941,652 bushels; To Montreal, 246,806 bushels; and to Sorel 93,565 bushels.

During the period from the opening of navigation to July 31, 1931, 62,649,578 bushels of wheat were moved by vessel from Fort William and Port Arthur, the distribution of which follows:- To Buffalo and Other U.S. Lake Ports, 26,557,550 bushels; To Canadian Lower Lake Ports, 25,331,095 bushels; To Montreal, 7,189,871 bushels; To Quebec 12,131 bushels; and to Sorel 299,065 bushels.

THE FOREIGN SITUATION

Ottawa, August 4, 1931. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics reports the receipt of a cablegram from the Indian Director of Statistics at Calcutta stating that the final estimate of wheat in India for the season 1930-31 is 347,274,000 bushels from 32,181,000 acres, as compared with 390,842,000 bushels from 31,654,000 acres for 1929-30 and with 332,416,000 bushels from 31,519,000 acres, the annual average for the five years 1926-30. The yield now reported, viz., 347,274,000 bushels is 11.1 per cent less than that of 1929-30 but is 4.5 per cent greater than the five-year average. The acreage of 32,181,000 acres is 1.7 per cent greater than that of 1929-30 and 2.1 per cent greater than the five-year average.



CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDED AUGUST 7, 1931.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 7, 1931, show a decrease of 4,644,277 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 107,855,936, Oats 8,605,224, Barley 9,158,993, Flax 786,994 and Rye 12,211,189, a total of 138,618,336 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 3,450,922, Oats 187,634 and Barley 1,092,340 bushels, while Flax and Rye show increases of 27,365 and 59,254 bushels respectively. For the same week last year the amount in store was 132,703,694 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 96,947,169, Oats 6,821,195, Barley 20,340,970, Flax 425,522 and Rye 8,168,838 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a decrease of 538,754 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 399,596, Oats 57,797, Barley 5,797, Flax 20,434 and Rye 55,130 bushels.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW):- Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 375,124 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 405,567 bushels, while decreases are noted in Oats 22,470, Barley 7,035 and Flax 938 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 460,884 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 469,556 bushels, while increases are noted in Oats of 4,761, Barley 1,349 and Rye 2,562 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR:- Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for previous week.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR:- Stocks at this elevator are nil.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR):- Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net decrease of 2,444,143 bushels. Wheat and Barley show decreases of 1,882,865 and 1,147,668 bushels respectively, while increases are noted in Oats of 16,164, Flax 50,877 and Rye 19,349 bushels.
