Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 7, 1931, show a decrease of 2,328,308 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 105,836,986, Oats 8,973,583, Barley 8,413,390, Flax 828,565 and Rye 12,237,504 a total of 136,290,028 bushels. Wheat and Barley show decreases of 2,018,950 and 745,603 bushels respectively, while increases are noted in Oats of 368,359, Flax 41,571 and Rye 26,315 bushels. For the same week last year the amount in store was 131,147,870 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 95,161,149, Oats 6,766,091, Barley 20,513,554, Flax 425,427 and Rye 8,281,649 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. - Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a net increase of 8,442 bushels. Increases are noted in Oats of 103,060, Flax 7,589 and Rye 14,013 bushels while Wheat and Barley show decreases of 104,003 and 14,217 bushels respectively.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW): - Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 407,340 bushels. Wheat and Oats show decreases of 394,621 and 12,838 bushels respectively, while increases are noted in Barley of 24 and Rye 55 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS: - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 146,216 bushels. Wheat and Oats show increases of 114,839 and 1,734 bushels respectively, while Rye shows a decrease of 357 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR: - Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for previous week.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR: - Stocks at this elevator are nil.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR): - Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net decrease of 2,917,764 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 2,605,503, Barley 375,602, and Rye 1,394 bushels, while Oats and Flax show increases of 31,409 and 36,526 bushels respectively.






