The ocean shipments from the Port of Vancouver increased slightly in volume over the previous week and over the corresponding week last year. A reduction in the amount forwarded from U. S. Atlantic Seaboard ports combined with the absence of any overseas movement from St. John and Halifax brought the weekly exports down to a little over half of those of the same week last year.

Stocks of Canadian wheat in the elevators and afloat in Canada and United States are gradually diminishing. The amount reported for this week amounted to 191,112,698 bushels, as compared with 193,826,839 bushels for the previous week. For the corresponding week in 1931, 193,926,695 bushels were reported, which is 2,813,997 bushels greater than the amount in store for the corresponding week this year.

Eastern Elevator stocks decreased slightly over the previous week, when 17,586,882 bushels were reported in store, as compared with 18,471,533 bushels for the previous week. For the same date in 1931, 22,940,535 bushels were reported in store.

Wheat stocks in U. S. positions decreased 1,577,640 bushels from the previous week. The amount reported was 19,410,690 bushels, as compared with 20,988,330 bushels of a week ago. For the same week in 1931, 22,316,789 bushels were in these elevators. The majority of the first amount is held in the elevators and afloat at Buffalo and New York, the amount being 13,575,622 and 4,725,722 bushels respectively.

Deliveries to the western Country Elevators and over the Loadings platforms for the week ended February 5th amounted to 2,040,819 bushels a reduction from the previous week when 3,435,724 bushels were reported. For the same week in 1931 the movement is shown as 1,574,975 bushels. During the period from August 1st to February 5th, 1932, some 208,696,848 bushels were received from the farms, as compared with 260,454,660 bushels for the same period to February 6, 1931.

Western inspections amounted to 1,725 cars compared with 2,138 cars for the same week a year ago. Of the former number 1,345 cars graded in the contract grades and 246 cars damp and tough while 1,345 cars were in the first four grades and 1,027 cars tough and damp for the week ended February 7, 1931.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 12, 1932.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending February 12, show a net decrease of 2,217,744 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 191,256,484, Oats 14,413,868, Barley 11,545,678, Flax 1,358,829 and Rye 12,773,463 bushels a total of 231,348,322 bushels. Wheat and Flax show decreases of 2,516,223 and 14,016 bushels respectively, while increases are noted in Oats of 191,914, Barley 43,785 and Rye 76,796 bushels. For the same week last year the amount in store was 252,926,592 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 193,926,695, Oats 13,584,884, Barley 29,978,855, Flax 2,134,178 and Rye 13,301,980 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a net decrease of 385,598 bushels. Wheat and Flax show decreases of 660,328 and 11,680 bushels respectively, while increases are noted in Oats of 217,246, Barley 59,042 and Rye 10,622 bushels.




