Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending September 11, 1931, show a net increase of 3,254,949 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 102,337,225, Oats 9,415,701, Barley 8,964,409, Flax 740,953 and Rye 12,176,783 bushels a total of 133,635,071 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 2,558,955, Oats 306,094, Barley 424,194 and Rye 611 bushels, while Flax shows a decrease of 35,105 bushels. For the same week last year the amount in store was 175,634,268 bushels, made up as follows: Wheat 131,218,687, Oats 7,361,807, Barley 25,012,991, Flax 687,600 and Rye 11,353,183 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a net increase of 4,864,357 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 4,789,976, Barley 74,568, Flax 14,359 and Rye 4,209 bushels, while Oats show a decrease of 18,755 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on September 4, 1931, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1930.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY):- Stocks for the week show an increase of 19,448 bushels, made up as follows: Wheat 5,009, Oats 3,017, Barley 10,397 and Rye 1,025 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS: Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 241,700 bushels. Wheat and Oats show decrease of 233,900 and 10,516 bushels respectively, while Rye shows an increase of 2,716 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR: Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for previous week.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR: Stocks at this elevator are nil.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR):- Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net decrease of 1,277,293 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 1,656,930, Flax 19,496 and Rye 88,303 bushels, while Oats and Barley show increases of 232,192 and 254,937 bushels respectively.






