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CANADIAN WHEAT STATISTICS

Some of the outstanding features of the Canadian wheat situation during the week ending October 14 were:- Slightly increased marketings on the Prairie Provinces and in the stocks of Canadian wheat in the elevators in Canada and the United States over those of the previous week, together with decreased export clearances as compared with a week ago.

Primary Movement

Deliveries of wheat to western country elevators and platform loadings for the week ending October 7, 1932 increased slightly over those of the previous week. The amount reported for the above week was 26,341,535 bushels as compared with 24,074,044 bushels for the previous week. During the corresponding week in 1931 17,150,462 bushels were marketed. For the first ten weeks of the crop year the deliveries of wheat to the country elevators and over the loading platforms amounted to 164,595,012 bushels, as compared with 79,861,485 bushels for the same period last year. Marketings of wheat up to October 7, 1932 in the three prairie provinces were as follows, the quantity within brackets being for the same period last year:- Manitoba 23,615,195 (13,494,206) bushels; Saskatchewan 91,403,669 (40,490,721) bushels; Alberta 11,124,133 (25,876,558) bushels.

Inspections 49,516,668

During the week ended October 14th, 1932 8,244 cars were inspected in the western division compared with 10,914 cars for the previous week and 6,304 cars for the corresponding week in 1931. The gradings show that 7,708 cars or 94 per cent were placed in the contract grades against 4,875 cars or 77 per cent for same week a year ago. According to inspection returns so far this season the quality of the wheat crop is the highest in years.

Stocks in store

Stocks of Canadian wheat in Canada and the United States elevators on October 14, increased over the previous week. The amount now shown in store is 222,386,914 bushels compared with 210,932,689 bushels for the previous week. The stocks for the same week a year ago amounted to 141,824,373 bushels. Increased stocks are shown in all the elevators except those at the Head of the Lakes and Vancouver. The largest increase took place at the western country elevators and in the in-transit wheat on the Great Lakes.

Export clearances

Export clearances for the week ending October 14, declines from those of the previous week, the amount reported shipped being 6,946,766 bushels as compared with 7,929,793 bushels a week ago. Decreased export clearances are shown in all the ports, except Vancouver, Quebec and Churchill. An outstanding feature is the increased export movement from Vancouver during the week.

It will be noted from the above that the bulk of the export shipments are going forward from Canadian seaboard ports. Practically all the Canadian ports show increases over the same period last year.

Water Movement

Lake shipments of wheat from the Head of the Lakes for the week ended October 14, 1932 amounted to 8,871,451 bushels; compared with ^{the} previous week when 6,565,562 bushels were reported. The distribution of the former amount was as follows: to Lake Huron and Georgian Bay ports 2,340,063 bushels; to Lower lake ports of Port Colborne, Toronto and Kingston 2,030,819 bushels; to Montreal 302,640 bushels; to Buffalo 4,144,736 bushels and to Europe 53,193 bushels. Slightly over half the Canadian lake movement was destined to Georgian Bay and Lake Huron ports while large shipments are noted to Buffalo. During the same week in 1931 4,693,394 bushels were shipped from the Head of the Lakes destined as follows:- to Buffalo 1,263,237 bushels; to Canadian lower lake ports 2,214,642 bushels; to Montreal 1,034,474 bushels and to Sorel 181,041 bushels.

Internal Movement

A slight reduction is shown in the receipts of wheat at the elevators in the western division as compared with the previous week, the amount being 38,841,447 bushels against 39,819,461 bushels a week ago. As in the previous week the majority of the former amount was received at the western country elevators and the Head of the Lakes, the quantities being shown as 25,439,864 bushels and 7,446,854 bushels respectively. The receipts at Vancouver were 2,401,484 bushels; at interior public, semi-public, private and mill elevators 1,849,493 bushels; at Churchill 635,580 bushels and at Victoria 68,172 bushels. Shipments from the above elevators totalled 28,004,621 bushels during the week, some 2,371,367 bushels in advance of a week ago. Principal shipments amounted to 15,836,159 bushels from the western country elevators; 8,033,616 bushels by vessel from the Head of the Lakes and export shipments from Vancouver were 2,548,271 bushels. In the eastern division 7,467,402 bushels and 457,805 bushels were received by vessel and rail respectively at the eastern elevators while 3,147,344 bushels were cleared for export from the ports of Montreal and Sorel. The movement by vessel from the lower lake ports to Montreal was shown as 1,658,874 bushels.

Destinations of Canadian Wheat Exports

During the month of September, according to Canadian Customs returns, the exports of wheat amounted to 26,874,237 bushels of which the British Empire countries received 19,731,154 bushels and Foreign countries 7,143,083 bushels. Of the former amount 19,562,435 bushels were destined to Great Britain, 116,000 bushels to Irish Free State; 35,703 to British South Africa and the balance 17,016 bushels to other Empire countries.

The chief countries making up the foreign export were Netherlands with 2,360,038 bushels, Belgium 1,451,332 bushels; Germany 1,185,755 bushels; and France 1,016,248 bushels while the remainder 1,129,710 bushels was made up of smaller amounts to other Foreign countries.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 14, 1932.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending October 14, 1932 show an increase of 13,854,203 bushels over the previous week. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 222,386,914, Oats 8,457,826, Barley 6,002,206, Flaxseed 1,527,501 and Rye 5,222,905 a total of 243,597,352 bushels. Increases are noted in all the grains as follows:- Wheat 13,155,172, Oats 506,939, Barley 76,134, Flaxseed 72,213 and Rye 43,763 bushels. For the same week a year ago the quantity in store was Wheat 141,824,373, Oats 9,610,215, Barley 11,541,265, Flaxseed 1,077,782 and Rye 12,281,496, bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:-

Grain stocks in these elevators show an increase of 7,772,888 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 7,142,059, Oats 506,564, Barley 51,726, Flaxseed 67,546 and Rye 4,993 bushels.


