CANADIAN WHEAT STATISTICS

During the week ending February 10, 1933 the Canadian wheat situation showed an increased movement to the western country elevators and over the loading platforms over those of the previous week, also a slight decrease in the export clearances. The stocks in the elevators declined from those of a week ago.

Primary Movement

For the week ending February 3, 1933 the marketings of wheat in the Prairie Provinces increased 1,026,695 bushels over those of the previous week, the amount being 3,439,058 bushels compared with 2,412,363 bushels a week ago. During the corresponding week in 1932, 2,040,819 bushels were moved from the farms.

During the first twenty-seven weeks of the crop year the deliveries of wheat to the western country elevators and shipments over the loading platforms amounted to 288,816,043 bushels as compared with 208,696,849 bushels for the same period last year. Marketings of wheat up to February 3, 1933 in the three Prairie Provinces were as follows, the quantity within brackets being for the same period last year:- Manitoba 30,104,463 (20,361,224) bushels; Saskatchewan 150,028,773 (94,995,279) bushels; and Alberta 108,682,807 (92,840,346) bushels.

Inspections

During the week ending February 7, 1933 only 1,613 cars of wheat were inspected in the Western Division compared with 3,227 cars a week ago and 1,920 cars for the same week in 1932. Of the 1,613 cars inspected, 1,557 cars were hard spring wheat, some 1,266 cars or 78 per cent graded No. 3 Northern and better while 209 cars were placed in the tough and damp grades. For the corresponding week in 1932, 1,494 cars or 77.8 per cent graded within the contract grades.

For the month of December, 1933, 8,379 cars were inspected in the Western Division of which 6,412 cars or 78.7 per cent were shown in the first four grades. The accumulated total inspections for the six months ending January, 1933 show 135,174 cars were inspected compared with 110,649 cars in 1932. Gradings show 119,995 cars or 92.84 per cent of the hard spring wheat were in the top four grades while for the same period in 1932 83,773 cars or 79.29 per cent of 1932 inspections graded No. 3 Northern and better.

Stocks in Store

Canadian wheat stocks in the elevators in Canada and the United States for the week ending February 10, 1933, decreased 1,358,892 bushels from those of the previous week. The amount reported in store for the week was 229,493,740 bushels compared with 230,852,632 bushels, the revised total for the previous week. During the corresponding week in 1932, 191,271,750 bushels were reported. Notable decreases were shown in the stocks at Vancouver and the United States Lake and Atlantic Seaboard ports from those of the previous week while increases are shown at western country elevators and the Head of the Lakes elevators.

Export Clearances

Export clearances slightly decreased from those of a week ago. The amount shown as shipped overseas was 3,148,831 bushels compared with 3,952,307 bushels a week ago. For the same week in 1932, 2,609,055 bushels were exported. The bulk of the wheat was exported from Vancouver with Maritime and United States Atlantic Seaboard ports next in order.

During the month of January, 1933, according to Customs Department figures, the exports of wheat amounted to 14,706,801 bushels compared with 27,735,999 bushels for the previous month and 9,472,346 bushels for the same month a year ago. The export of 14,706,801 bushels of wheat for January, 1933, has not been exceeded for the corresponding month since 1928. The routing shows that 12,552,448 bushels left Canada from the Pacific Ports, 2,124,419 bushels via Canadian Atlantic Ports and only 29,934 bushels were billed via the United States Ports. There was no re-routed wheat during the month.

For the six months ending January 31, 1932, 155,101,260 bushels of wheat were exported compared with 104,450,432 bushels for the same period in 1932. The following amounts were exported from Canada through the undermentioned ports: Vancouver 55,986,141 bushels; Montreal 41,717,924 bushels; Sorel 9,487,876 bushels; Saint John 2,611,758 bushels; Prince Rupert 677,813 bushels; Victoria 596,121 bushels; New Westminster 436,310 bushels; Halifax 72,664 bushels; North Sydney 101 bushels and Churchill 2,735,939 bushels; a total of 115,540,886 bushels.

The amount billed via United States ports was 39,530,476 bushels and as there was no re-routed wheat during the month of January, the amount would be the same as for the five month period, which was 16,669,233 bushels. After adding this amount to the exports from Canadian ports and deducting same from the quantity billed via United States ports makes the adjusted total 132,210,119 bushels exported via Canadian ports and 22,861,243 bushels via United States ports.

Oats exported during the month of January 1933 amounted to 354,614 bushels against 1,184,647 bushels in 1932. For the six months ending January 1933, 7,307,625 bushels were exported while 6,311,695 bushels were exported for the same period in 1932.

Barley exports during January 1933 amounted to 191,524 bushels compared with 231,707 bushels for the same month in 1932. During the same six months ending January, 1933, 4,247,633 bushels were exported all of which left Canada via Canadian ports while 7,833,298 bushels were moved for the same period in 1932, 1,711,788 bushels passing through United States Atlantic ports.

Rye exports amounted to 17,143 bushels for the month compared with 218,504 bushels for the same month in 1932. During the six-month period, 2,563,101 bushels were exported against 2,911,166 bushels for the same period in 1932.

Flaxseed shows an export of 1,400 bushels during the month. No export is shown for the same month in 1932. The six-month period export amounted to 363,978 bushels against 245,763 for the same period in 1932.

Destination of Wheat Exports

The majority of wheat exports in the month of January 1933 were billed to the United Kingdom according to customs export entries, the amount being 9,587,195 bushels while for the six months 105,233,663 bushels were so destined. The most important countries to which wheat was exported for the six month period were:- Belgium 10,177,480 bushels; Netherlands 11,067,837 bushels; Germany 6,148,131 bushels; France 5,898,141 bushels; China 5,769,490 bushels; Italy 2,436,503 bushels; Japan 2,387,110 bushels; and Norway 1,726,341 bushels.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 10, 1933.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending February 10, 1933 show a net decrease of 632,343 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- wheat 229,139,127, oats 9,244,036, barley 6,767,631, flaxseed 1,453,580 and rye 5,044,326 bushels; a total of 251,048,700 bushels. Decreases noted were:- wheat 632,343, oats 22,610, barley 2,509 and flaxseed 26,177 bushels while rye increased 34,028 bushels. For the corresponding week the previous year stocks in store were:- wheat 191,271,750, oats 14,850,609, barley 11,553,844, flaxseed 1,355,223 and rye 12,765,032 bushels making a total of 231,797,458 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks of grain in store show a net increase of 729,886 bushels made up as follows:- wheat 605,399, oats 64,283, barley 42,423, flaxseed 6,908 and rye 10,873 bushels.
