Canadian Wheat Statistics

During the week ending May 12, 1933, export clearances of wheat were lower than during the preceding week. Primary receipts also decreased for the week and the visible supply contracted by over 3½ million bushels.

Primary Movement of Wheat

During the week ending May 5, primary receipts of wheat amounted to 2,127,592 bushels as compared with 2,749,600 bushels for the previous week and 627,540 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

From August 1, 1932 to May 5, 1933 marketings in the Prairie Provinces amounted to 331,716,868 bushels compared with marketings of 238,681,343 bushels during the corresponding period in 1931-32. Marketings by provinces are shown as follows, with figures for the same period in 1931-32 in brackets: Manitoba 33,663,299 (22,207,509) bushels; Saskatchewan 168,878,949 (106,547,858) bushels; and Alberta 129,174,620 (110,285,085) bushels.

Inspections

During the month of April a total of 8,576 cars of wheat were inspected in the Western Division. These inspections included 407 cars of Durum wheat. Of total inspections of 8,169 cars, exclusive of Durum wheat, 7,338 cars graded No. 3 Northern or better. Total inspections for the month were slightly higher than the same month last year.

Stocks in Store

A decrease of 3,555,386 bushels is reported in the stocks of wheat in store for the week ending May 12, as compared with the previous week. On May 12, the Canadian visible supply was reported at 212,350,899 bushels compared with the revised figure of 215,906,285 bushels for the previous week and 157,051,237 bushels for the corresponding week last year. The seasonal rise and fall in the visible supply of Canadian wheat during 1932-33 affords an interesting contrast with the previous crop year. During the present crop year the visible supply reached its high point early in November while in 1931-32 the peak was reached two months and a half later or about the middle of January. The extremely rapid primary movement in the fall of 1932 contributed to the early increase in visible supply figures. Since January 1, 1933 the decrease in the visible supply has been less than during the same period last year. Between January 1, 1933 and May 12, 1933 the decrease in the visible supply has amounted to 26 million bushels while between the same dates in 1932 the decrease amounted to 35 million bushels. Between April 1, 1933 and May 12, 1933 the decrease in the visible supply has amounted to 15 million bushels as compared with a decrease of 28 million bushels during the corresponding period last year.

Another interesting aspect of visible supply figures at the present time is the relatively small stocks of wheat held in United States positions. On May 12, 1933 a total of 3,012,398 bushels of Canadian wheat were in store in the United States. On the same date last year 6,731,736 bushels were in store in the same position. Visible supply figures for the past week show the small total of 225,730 bushels in store at United States Atlantic ports as compared with 2,749,630 bushels on the same date last year.

A sharp decrease is shown in the volume of wheat in transit on the Great Lakes on May 12, 1933 as compared with the previous week. On May 12, 1933 a total of 3,300,238 bushels of wheat was reported on passage as compared with 7,461,242 bushels on May 5, 1933, and 2,441,585 bushels on the corresponding date last year.

Loadings at Port Arthur and Fort William

From May 8, 1933 to May 14, 1933 forty-five boats loaded grain at Port Arthur and Fort William. The quantity of wheat placed afloat amounted to 5,810,596 bushels. Of this amount 3,621,334 bushels were destined to Canadian lower lake ports, 1,458,654 bushels to Montreal, 108,000 bushels to Sorel and 622,507 bushels to United States ports.

Export Clearances of Wheat

Export clearances of wheat for the week ending May 12 amounted to 3,880,666 bushels compared with 4,258,265 bushels for the previous week and 5,720,010 for the corresponding week last year.

During the week ending May 12, 1933, Quebec reported increased clearances while all other Canadian ports show decreased shipments. Shipments from United States ports showed a small increase over shipments of the previous week.

From August 1, 1932 to May 12, 1933 export clearances amounted to 183,423,208 bushels compared with 127,715,335 bushels for the same period in 1931-32.



INTERNATIONAL MOVEMENT

World shipments of wheat and wheat flour for the week ending May 14, 1933 amounted to 12,526,000 bushels compared with 12,786,000 bushels for the preceding week and 18,616,000 bushels for the same week last year. North American shipments amounted to 4,532,000 bushels, a reduction of about 900,000 bushels from the previous week. Argentine shipments of 4,080,000 bushels were higher than during the previous week and Australian shipments of 3,902,000 bushels were about equal to those of the preceding week. Clearances from other countries were insignificant.

From August 1, 1932 to May 14, 1933, World shipments amounted to 504 million bushels as compared with 641 million bushels for the same period in 1931-32. Shipments to date from exporting countries during 1932-33 and 1931-32 are as follows:- (Broomhall's figures)

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING MAY 12, 1933.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending May 12, 1933 show a net decrease of 3,770,307 bushels. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 212,350,899, oats 10,478,291, barley 6,535,703, flaxseed 1,261,086 and rye 4,983,101 bushels, a total of 235,609,080 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 3,555,386, flaxseed 158,349 and rye 110,452 bushels while oats and barley increased 6,678 and 47,202 bushels respectively. For the corresponding week last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 157,051,237, oats 8,568,012, barley 7,276,026, flaxseed 1,359,855 and rye 9,825,157 bushels, a total of 184,080,287 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks show a net decrease of 2,172,078 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 1,781,191, oats 380,073 and barley 23,111 bushels while flaxseed and rye increased 5,997 and 6,300 bushels respectively.


PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR.- Grain stocks remain unchanged.

IN TRANSIT LAKES.- Grain in transit shows a net decrease of 4,280,345 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 4,161,004, oats 22,577 and flaxseed 181,993 bushels while barley increased 85,229 bushels.


