WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

An increase of 2,138,834 bushels is reported in the stocks of wheat in store on July 7th, as compared with the previous week. The Canadian visible supply was reported at 201,251,580 bushels compared with the revised figure of 199,112,746 bushels for the previous week and 136,063,968 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Continued rising prices have encouraged more wheat to come forward from the farms while the overseas movement has decreased thus increasing the visible supply.

Canadian wheat in store in the United States amounted to 5,131,215 bushels as compared with 4,336,626 bushels on the same date last year.

In transit wheat on the Great Lakes amounted to 4,093,383 bushels on July 7th, 1933. On July 8th, 1932, 3,195,990 bushels were in transit on the lakes.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

The wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces amounted to 3,476,705 bushels for the week ending June 30th, 1933, a decrease of 1,088,952 bushels compared with those of the previous week when 4,565,657 bushels were marketed. For the same week in 1932, 3,461,457 bushels were marketed.

Marketings in the Prairie Provinces during the crop year to date amounted to 360,218,924 bushels compared with marketings of 262,483,647 bushels during the corresponding period in 1931-32. Marketings by provinces are as follows; with figures for the same period in 1931-32 given in brackets: Manitoba, 37,275,275 (24,553,678) bushels; Saskatchewan, 182,339,342 (117,484,282) bushels; and Alberta 140,604,307 (120,445,687) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES OF WHEAT

Export clearances of wheat for the week ending July 6th, 1933, amounted to 2,578,824 bushels compared with 2,959,673 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 380,849 bushels. For the corresponding week in 1932, 3,766,371 bushels were reported.

From August 1st, 1932, to July 6th, 1933, export clearances of wheat amounted to 215,131,436 bushels, compared with 161,681,006 bushels for the corresponding period in 1931-32.

During the week ending July 9, 1933 world shipments of wheat and wheat flour amounted to 9,957,000 bushels compared with 7,963,000 bushels for the previous week and 10,355,000 bushels for the corresponding period last year. Shipments from North America and the Argentine increased compared with the preceding week while clearances from Australia were lower.

From August 1, 1932 to July 9, 1933 world shipments of wheat amounted to 535 million compared with 743 million bushels for the same period in 1931-32.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending July 7, 1933 show a net increase of 5,213,666 bushels compared with the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 201,251,580, oats 10,860,625, barley 7,206,844, flaxseed 1,118,566 and rye 7,560,394 bushels a total of 227,998,009 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 2,138,834, oats 552,710, barley 254,710 and rye 2,276,111 bushels while flaxseed decreased 8,699 bushels. For the corresponding week last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 176,063,968, oats 5,431,905, barley 4,189,911, flaxseed 1,338,701 and rye 6,701,583 bushels, a total of 153,726,068 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks in store decreased 2,130,776 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 2,120,931, barley 33,598, flaxseed 34,097 and rye 6,808 bushels while oats increased 64,658 bushels.
