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WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

A decrease of 784,471 bushels is reported in the stocks of wheat in store on July 14, as compared with the previous week. The Canadian visible supply was reported at 200,607,237 bushels compared with the revised figure of 201,391,708 bushels for the previous week and 134,356,040 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Canadian wheat in store in the United States amounted to 6,755,041 bushels as compared with 5,986,156 bushels on the same date last year.

In transit wheat on the Great Lakes amounted to 3,685,175 bushels on July 14, 1933. On July 15, 1932 6,373,248 bushels were in transit on the lakes.

PRIMARY MARKETING

The wheat marketings in the Prairie provinces amounted to 3,091,223 bushels for the week ending July 7, 1933, a decrease of 385,482 bushels compared with those of the previous week when 3,476,705 bushels were marketed. For the same week in 1932 1,827,442 bushels were reported.

Marketings in the Prairie Provinces during the crop year to date amounted to 363,310,147 bushels compared with marketings of 264,311,089 bushels during the corresponding period in 1931-32. Marketings by provinces are as follows, with figures for the same period in 1931-32 given in brackets: Manitoba, 37,803,024 (24,680,271) bushels; Saskatchewan, 183,682,111 (118,363,184) bushels; and Alberta 141,825,012 (121,267,334) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES OF WHEAT

Export clearances of wheat for the week ending July 14, 1933, amounted to 1,802,001 bushels compared with 2,578,824 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 776,823 bushels. For the corresponding week in 1932, 2,859,453 bushels were reported.

From August 1st, 1932, to July 13, 1933, export clearances of wheat amounted to 216,933,437 bushels compared with 164,540,459 bushels for the corresponding period in 1931-32.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JULY 14, 1933.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending July 14, 1933 show a net decrease of 378,415 bushels compared with the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 200,607,237, oats 11,222,180, barley 7,433,219, flaxseed 1,094,984 and rye 5,672,115 bushels a total of 226,029,735 bushels. Increases are noted in oats of 159,835, barley 169,550 and rye 106,811 bushels, while wheat and flaxseed show decreases of 784,471 and 30,140 bushels respectively. For the same week last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 134,356,040, oats 5,463,893, barley 3,762,966, flaxseed 1,191,605 and rye 6,247,554 a total of 151,022,058 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks in store show a decrease of 2,012,788, bushels made up as follows:- wheat 1,875,840, oats 22,655, barley 17,865, flaxseed 71,799 and rye 24,629 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS.- Stocks for the week show a net increase of 2,409 bushels. Oats and barley show increases of 5,289 and 1,681 bushels respectively, while wheat shows a decrease of 4,561 bushels.

VANCOUVER AND NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show an increase of 703,802 bushels made up as follows:- wheat 556,294, oats 93,054, barley 35,308 and rye 19,146 bushels.

Stocks at Prince Rupert, Victoria and Churchill Elevators remain the same as for the previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Grain stocks for the week show a net decrease of 289,554 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 668,706 bushels, while increases are noted in oats of 103,577, barley 122,185, flaxseed 41,482 and rye 111,908 bushels.

IN TRANSIT LAKES.- Grain in transit shows a net decrease of 504,046 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 408,208, oats 75,276 and flaxseed 48,000 bushels, while barley shows an increase of 27,438 bushels.


