WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending November 10, 1933 shows a decrease of 2,004,551 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported at 249,791,365 bushels compared with a revised figure of 251,795,916 bushels for the previous week and 241,485,978 bushels for the corresponding week in 1932.

Canadian wheat in store in the United States amounted to 10,562,536 bushels compared with 15,913,593 bushels on the same date last year.

In transit wheat on the Great Lakes amounted to 2,875,513 bushels on November 10. On November 11, 1932, 4,170,548 bushels were in transit on the Lakes.

United States wheat in Canada was 2,656,046 bushels compared with 7,445,481 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending November 3 amounted to 7,742,939 bushels, an increase of 2,419,372 bushels compared with the 5,323,567 bushels marketed in the previous week. During the corresponding week in 1932, 10,948,339 bushels were marketed. For the fourteen weeks ending November 3, 1933 and November 4, 1932, 131,402,485 and 225,955,017 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending November 3 were as follows: Manitoba 637,025 bushels; Saskatchewan 4,183,954 bushels; Alberta 2,921,960 bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to November 3, 1933 as compared with the same period in 1932 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1932: Manitoba 21,187,753 (26,466,062) bushels; Saskatchewan 66,253,966 (124,319,472) bushels; Alberta 43,955,769 (75,169,483) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending November 10, 1933 the export clearances amounted to 4,695,545 bushels compared with 3,532,353 bushels for the previous week, an increase of 1,113,192 bushels. During the corresponding week in 1932, 6,241,787 bushels were cleared for overseas ports.

Exports via Shipping Routes

According to Canadian Customs returns 23,305,510 bushels of wheat were exported from Canada of which 99,411 bushels were destined to the United States for consumption; 7,648,358 bushels were exported via United States ports to overseas countries; 11,662,493 bushels were shipped from Canadian Atlantic Seaboard ports and 3,805,248 bushels from Canadian Pacific ports a total of 15,557,741 bushels. Of the 7,648,358 bushels moved via United States Atlantic Seaboard ports some 863,033 bushels were re-routed back into Canadian channels increasing the Canadian movement to 16,420,774 bushels during the month and decreasing the United States movement to 6,785,325 bushels.

During the three months ending October 1933, 51,624,831 bushels were exported from Canada, this compared with 85,356,484 bushels for the same period during the previous year. Of the former amount 99,521 bushels were exported to United States for consumption, 12,861,274 bushels moved via United States ports, 27,757,544 bushels were exported via Canadian Atlantic ports, 8,504,613 bushels via Canadian Pacific ports and 2,401,879 bushels via the Port of Churchill a total of 38,664,036 bushels.

The re-routed wheat from United States to Canadian ports amounted to 947,033 bushels which increases the Canadian ports movement to 39,611,069 bushels and decreases the export via United States ports to 11,914,241 bushels.

Wheatflour exports during the three months ending October 1933 amounted to 1,547,212 barrels an increase of 302,923 barrels over the same period in 1932. The majority of the former amount left Canada direct from the Canadian Atlantic and Pacific ports, the quantity being 1,104,237 barrels and 317,262 barrels respectively. The movement via United States ports overseas was 55,537 barrels, while 513 barrels were exported to the United States direct.

Oats exported during the month of October totalled only 320,804 bushels and for the three months 724,561 bushels and with the exception of 23,307 bushels exported direct to the United States the remainder of the latter moved via Canadian Atlantic and Pacific ports.

Barley exports amounted to 135,966 bushels during the month of October and 256,170 bushels for the three months ending October, 1933. This barley went to overseas countries from Canadian Atlantic and Pacific ports.

Rye exports for October 1933 show a gratifying increase over the same month in 1932. The amount exported being 918,795 bushels and 403,802 bushels respectively. Of the former amount 779,831 bushels were exported to the United States direct for consumption, the remainder moved to overseas countries. During the three months ending October 1933, 2,192,741 bushels were exported of which 2,010,302 bushels were destined to the United States for consumption, 121,877 bushels were moved via United States Atlantic ports and 59,944 via Canadian Atlantic ports.

International Trade

World shipments for the week ending November 13, amounted to 9,594,000 bushels as compared with shipments of 9,358,000 bushels for the previous week and 14,128,000 bushels for the corresponding week last year. Shipments from North America increased by over one million bushels, while Argentine clearances show a decrease of almost half a million bushels. Australian shipments also decreased slightly during the past week.

During the first fifteen weeks of the present crop year world shipments amounted to 151 million bushels compared with 162 million bushels for the corresponding weeks last year. North American shipments have amounted to 68 million bushels compared with 103 million bushels last year. Since August 1, 1933 the Argentine has cleared 31 million bushels of wheat compared with 11 million for the same weeks last year. Australian shipments have been slightly smaller than last year.



As shown by the above table, world shipments of wheat have averaged 10.1 million bushels per week during the first fifteen weeks of the crop year as compared with 10.8 and 16.5 million bushels per week during the corresponding period in 1932-33 and 1931-32. North American shipments have averaged 4.6 million bushels per week compared with 6.8 and 6.9 million bushels per week during the first fifteen weeks of 1932-33 and 1931-32. Argentine shipments have averaged 2.1 million bushels per week as compared with .8 million bushels during the same period last year.

Import Requirement Estimate

The London Wheat Conference estimated world import requirements for 1933-34 at 560 million bushels. From August 1, 1933 to November 13, 1933 world shipments amounted to 151 million bushels, or an average of 10.1 million bushels per week. This leaves a balance of 409 million bushels to be shipped during the remaining 37 weeks of the crop year or a weekly average of 11.0 million bushels per week.



CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING NOVEMBER 10, 1933.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending November 10, 1933 shows a decrease of 1,921,312 bushels as compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows.- wheat 249,791,365, oats 19,848,955, barley 11,895,361, flaxseed 854,915 and rye 4,199,443 bushels, a total of 286,590,039 bushels. Decreases noted were as follows.- wheat 2,004,551, barley 44,660, flaxseed 49,270 and rye 344,188 bushels while oats increased 521,357 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows.- wheat 241,485,978, oats 8,238,433, barley 5,236,785, flaxseed 1,693,270 and rye 4,895,878 bushels, a total of 261,550,344 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks for this week increased 790,046 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 577,649, oats 198,278 and barley 19,389 bushels while flaxseed and rye decreased 5,012 and 258 bushels respectively.
