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WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending December 15, 1933 shows a decrease of 429,844 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 243,003,692 bushels compared with a revised figure of 243,433,536 bushels for the previous week and 236,876,992 bushels for the corresponding week in 1932.

Canadian wheat in store in the United States amounted to 15,357,446 bushels compared with 14,903,857 bushels on the same date last year.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2,248,845 bushels compared with 6,982,856 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending December 8 amounted to 3,250,295 bushels a decrease of 705,316 bushels compared with those of the previous week when 3,955,611 bushels were marketed. During the same period in 1932, 6,633,350 bushels were reported. For the nineteen weeks ending December 8, 1933 and December 9, 1932, 154,635,464 and 266,229,927 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending December 8, 1933 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the same week in 1932: Manitoba 173,127 (653,492); Saskatchewan 1,681,139 (2,625,591); Alberta 1,396,029 (3,353,267) bushels.


Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces in the 19 weeks to December 8, 1933 as compared with the same period in 1932 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1932: Manitoba 22,618,419 (29,032,205) bushels; Saskatchewan 78,210,359 (142,210,638) bushels; Alberta 53,806,686 (94,987,084) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending December 15, 1933 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,382,697 bushels compared with 3,326,788 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 1,668,466 bushels. During the corresponding week in 1932, 3,051,163 bushels were cleared for overseas ports.

EXPORTS BY COUNTRIES OF DESTINATION

During the four months ending November, 1933, 74,768,789 bushels of wheat were exported from Canada according to Customs figures. This compares with 112,658,460 bushels for the same period in 1932.



Wheatflour exports during the four months ending November were 2,094,814 barrels, an increase of 273,661 barrels over the same period in 1932, when 1,821,153 barrels were sent out of the country. Of the former amount Great Britain received 946,922 barrels; Irish Free State 167,001 barrels; Newfoundland 152,083 barrels; British West Indies 280,565 barrels; Hong Kong 77,149 barrels; Japan 62,950 barrels; Norway 62,076 barrels, while smaller amounts went to other British and foreign countries.

Oats exports for the four month period amounted to 1,320,141 bushels compared with 5,519,146 bushels. Great Britain is the chief country of import with 727,950 bushels. The other important countries in order of quantity were:- Newfoundland 197,071 bushels, British West Indies 73,463 bushels, Bermuda 92,774 bushels, and Belgium 65,882 bushels.

Barley exports amounted to only 426,080 against 3,783,442 bushels for the four months ended November, 1932. Of the former amount 410,799 bushels went to Great Britain, 10,281 bushels to the Netherlands and 5,000 bushels to Hong Kong.



CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING DEC. 15, 1933.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending December 15, 1933 show a net decrease of 376,970 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows: wheat 243,003,692, oats 20,145,463, barley 11,303,260, flaxseed 624,360 and rye 4,129,075 bushels a total of 279,706,355 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 429,844, and barley 57,732 bushels while increases are noted in oats of 96,290, flaxseed 7,295 and rye 7,021 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- Wheat 236,876,992, oats 9,536,761, barley 6,515,380, flaxseed 1,473,087 and rye 4,911,186 bushels a total of 259,313,406 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks show a net increase of 583,133 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 577,407, oats 29,426 and rye 680 bushels while decreases are noted in barley and flaxseed of 20,061 and 4,269 bushels respectively.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 696,858 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 703,723 and barley 430 bushels while oats increased 7,300 bushels.

VANCOUVER AND NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 30,401 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 14,474 and barley 30,511 bushels while oats increased 14,577 bushels.
