WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending February 16, 1934 shows a decrease of 278,218 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 232,557,145 bushels compared with a revised figure of 232,835,363 bushels for the previous week and 226,515,659 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 8,593,159 bushels of which 3,722,001 bushels and 3,629,183 bushels were in store or afloat at Buffalo and New York respectively. This compares with 9,408,849 bushels on the same date last year of which 6,173,885 bushels were located at Buffalo and 1,204,065 bushels at New York.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2,248,845 bushels compared with 6,675,007 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending February 9, 1934 amounted to 2,081,402 bushels, an increase of 211,349 bushels compared with those of the previous week when 1,870,053 bushels were marketed. During the same week in 1933, 2,109,930 bushels were marketed. For the twenty-eight weeks ending February 9, 1934 and February 10, 1933, 174,121,554 bushels and 290,925,973 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending February 9, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the same week in 1933: Manitoba 118,961 (164,483) bushels; Saskatchewan 935,679 (672,906) bushels; Alberta 1,026,762 (1,272,541) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to February 9, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1932-33 were as follows, figures in brackets being those for 1932-33: Manitoba 23,456,119 (30,268,946) bushels; Saskatchewan 86,600,403 (150,701,679) bushels; Alberta 64,065,032 (109,955,348) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending February 16, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 2,013,367 bushels compared with 2,388,271 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 374,904 bushels. During the corresponding week in 1933, 4,583,231 bushels were cleared for overseas ports.



World shipments for the week ending February 19, amounted to 10,195,000 bushels as compared with shipments of 11,522,000 bushels for the previous week and 17,664,000 bushels for the corresponding week in 1932-33. Shipments from North America decreased slightly during the past week. Clearances from the Argentine and Australia were slightly lower and Russian shipments showed a decrease of 248,000 bushels during the past week.

During the first twenty-nine weeks of the present crop year, world shipments amounted to 298 million bushels compared with 349 million bushels for the corresponding weeks of the last crop year. North American shipments have amounted to 130 million bushels compared with 188 million bushels in 1932-33. Since August 1, 1933, the Argentine has cleared 61 million bushels of wheat compared with 45 million bushels for the same weeks of the last crop year. Australian shipments have amounted to 51 million bushels compared with 79 million bushels in 1932-33. Russian shipments amounted to 25 million bushels compared with 17 million bushels for the same period last year.

Weekly Average Shipments

The following table shows weekly average shipments of wheat for the first twenty-nine weeks of the present crop year along with comparative figures for 1932-33 and 1931-32.

As shown by the above table, world shipments of wheat have averaged 10.3 million bushels per week during the first twenty-nine weeks of the crop year as compared with 12.0 and 15.2 million bushels per week during the corresponding period in 1932-33 and 1931-32. North American shipments have averaged 4.5 million bushels per week compared with 6.5 and 6.4 million bushels per week during the first twenty-nine weeks of 1932-33 and 1931-32. Argentine shipments have averaged 2.1 million bushels per week as compared with 1.6 million bushels during the same period in the last crop year.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 16, 1934

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending Feb. 16, 1934 show a net decrease of 197,669 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- Wheat 232,557,145, Oats 18,913,742, barley 10,917,379, flaxseed 604,826 and rye 4,058,309 bushels a total of 267,051,401 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 278,218, barley 17,348 and rye 1,606 bushels while increases are shown in oats 97,632 and flaxseed 1,871 bushels. At a corresponding date last year stocks in store were as follows: wheat 226,515,659, oats 9,189,845, barley 6,718,595, flaxseed 1,456,921 and rye 5,089,913 bushels; a total of 248,970,933 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks in store this week show a net increase of 79,298 bushels. Increases are noted in oats of 205,657, flaxseed 1,480 and rye 3,827 bushels, while decreases are shown in wheat and barley of 96,875 and 34,791 bushels respectively.



VANCOUVER AND NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 492,301 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 388,004 and oats 111,181 bushels while barley decreased 6,884 bushels.
