WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending March 16, 1934 shows a decrease of 2,230,095 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 225,660,441 bushels compared with a revised figure of 227,890,536 bushels for the previous week and 224,538,070 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 7,840,846 bushels of which 2,604,167 bushels were in store in Buffalo, 1,816,265 bushels at New York and 2,777,000 bushels at Albany, N.Y. This compared with 6,947,789 bushels on the same date last year of which 5,166,320 bushels were located at Buffalo, 224,476 bushels at New York and 820,069 bushels at Boston.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2,228,643 bushels compared with 6,492,827 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending March 9, 1934 amounted to 2,226,768 bushels an increase of 655,416 bushels compared with those of the previous week when 1,571,352 bushels were marketed. During the same week in 1933, 4,190,522 bushels were marketed. For the thirty-two weeks ending March 9, 1934 and March 10, 1933, 182,449,838 bushels and 304,620,093 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending March 9, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the same week in 1933. Manitoba 184,438 (437,065) bushels; Saskatchewan 979,182 (1,649,852) bushels, Alberta 1,063,148 (2,103,605) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to March 9, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1932-33 were as follows, figures in brackets being those for 1932-33: Manitoba 24,134,588 (31,367,745) bushels; Saskatchewan 90,050,931 (156,095,286) bushels; Alberta 68,264,319 (117,357,062) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES


During the week ending March 16, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,866,143 bushels compared with 1,910,350 bushels for the previous week. During the corresponding week in 1933, 2,855,231 bushels were cleared for overseas ports.

World shipments for the week ending March 19, amounted to 11,305,000 bushels as compared with shipments of 11,626,000 bushels for the previous week and 12,528,000 bushels for the corresponding week in 1932-33. Shipments from North America showed a slight decrease during the past week. Clearances from the Argentine and Australia showed decreases of 153,000 bushels and 115,000 bushels respectively, as compared with the previous week.

Weekly Average Shipments

The following table shows weekly average shipments of wheat for the first thirty-three weeks of the present crop year along with comparative figures for 1932-33 and 1931-32.

As shown by the above table world shipments of wheat have averaged 10.3 million bushels per week during the first thirty-three weeks of the crop year as compared with 12.5 and 15.4 million bushels per week during the corresponding period in 1932-33 and 1931-32. North American shipments have averaged 4.4 million bushels per week compared with 6.2 and 6.1 million bushels per week during the first thirty-three weeks of 1932-33 and 1931-32. Argentine shipments have averaged 2.4 million bushels per week as compared with 1.9 million bushels during the same period in the last crop year.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING MARCH 16, 1934.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending March 16, 1934 show a decrease of 2,928,145 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 225,660,441, oats, 17,182,058, barley 10,611,603, flaxseed 570,695 and rye 4,031,933 bushels; a total of 258,056,730 bushels. The decrease was made up as follows:- wheat 2,230,095, oats 583,744, barley 106,449, flaxseed, 5,735 and rye 2,072 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 224,538,070, oats 10,783,614, barley 6,794,677, flaxseed 1,444,707 and rye 5,130,328 bushels, a total of 248,691,396 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks this week show a net decrease of 776,933 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 432,471, oats 330,046, barley 15,430 and rye 1,249 bushels while flaxseed increased 2,263 bushels.


INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS.- Stocks for the week show a net increase of 23,644 bushels. Increases are noted in oats of 7,865 and barley 19,420 bushels while wheat decreased 3,641 bushels.

VANCOUVER AND NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 58,764 bushels. Wheat decreased 151,205 bushels while increases are shown in oats and barley of 71,395 and 21,046 bushels respectively.

PRINCE RUPERT AND CHURCHILL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks remain same as previous week.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR.- Grain stocks decreased 500 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Grain stocks show a net increase of 747,773 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 782,179, barley 3,423 and rye 9,576 bushels while decreases are shown in oats of 42,360 and flaxseed 5,040 bushels.




