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WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending April 20, 1934 shows a decrease of 4,149,427 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 215,739,775 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 219,889,202 bushels for the previous week and 220,371,631 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 3,073,479 bushels of which 389,204 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 960,008 bushels at New York and 1,498,000 bushels at Albany, N.Y. This compared with 3,099,856 bushels on the same date last year of which 2,291,341 bushels were located at Buffalo, 95,974 bushels at New York and 212,565 bushels at Boston.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2,228,643 bushels compared with 5,794,342 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending April 13, 1934 amounted to 1,733,824 bushels, a decrease of 439,288 bushels compared with those of the previous week when 2,173,112 bushels were marketed. During the same week in 1933, 2,042,994 bushels were marketed. For the thirty-seven weeks ending April 13, 1934 and April 14, 1933, 192,390,240 bushels and 324,191,732 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending April 13, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the same week in 1933: Manitoba 73,730 (134,445) bushels; Saskatchewan 903,075 (1,022,643) bushels; Alberta 757,019 (885,906) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to April 13, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1932-33 were as follows, figures in brackets being those for 1932-33: Manitoba 24,947,674 (33,024,915) bushels; Saskatchewan 94,991,703 (165,141,684) bushels; Alberta 72,450,863 (126,025,133) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending April 20, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,497,598 bushels compared with 2,256,498 bushels for the previous week. During the corresponding week in 1933, 2,444,355 bushels were cleared for overseas ports.

World shipments for the week ending April 23, 1934 amounted to 8,151,000 bushels as compared with shipments of 10,714,000 bushels for the previous week and 10,136,000 bushels for the corresponding week in 1932-33. Shipments from North America decreased slightly last week as compared with the previous week. Clearances from the Argentine showed a decrease of 2,396,000 bushels while Australian shipments were slightly higher than last week.

Weekly Average Shipments

The following table shows weekly average shipments of wheat for the first thirty-eight weeks of the present crop year along with comparative figures for 1932-33 and 1931-32.

As shown by the above table world shipments of wheat have averaged 10.2 million bushels per week during the first thirty-eight weeks of the crop year as compared with 12.3 and 15.4 million bushels per week during the corresponding period in 1932-33 and 1931-32. North American shipments have averaged 4.5 million bushels per week compared with 5.9 million bushels per week during the first thirty-eight weeks of 1932-33. Argentine shipments have averaged 2.5 million bushels per week as compared with 2.1 million bushels during the same period in the last crop year.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING APRIL 20, 1934.

- Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending April 20, 1934 show a decrease of 4,992,726 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 215,739,775, oats 14,283,799, barley 10,299,789
- flaxseed 549,269 and rye 4,192,584 bushels a total of 245,065,216 bushels. Decreases noted were as follows:- wheat 4,149,427, oats 768,866, barley 42,763, flaxseed 5,431 and rye 26,239 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 220,371,631, oats 11,180,468, barley 6,396,183, flaxseed 1,303,343 and rye 5,136,825 bushels a total of 244,388,450 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks in store decreased 3,173,991 bushels made up as follows:- wheat 2,700,377, oats 412,536, barley 48,903 flaxseed 68 and rye 12,107 bushels.



Rail shipments from August 1, 1933 to date amounted to wheat 125,424 and rye 2,630 bushels.




