WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending May 11, 1934 shows a slight decrease of 241,311 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 202,716,938 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 202,958,249 bushels for the previous week and 211,875,338 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 1,682,328 bushels of which 580,766 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 201,404 bushels at New York and 476,000 bushels at Albany, N.Y. This compared with 3,012,398 bushels on the same date last year of which 1,774,719 bushels were located at Buffalo and 197,730 bushels at New York.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 704,004 bushels compared with 4,898,285 bushels last year.

A large increase is shown in the "In Transit" wheat on the lakes when 7,398,924 bushels were reported compared with 3,300,238 bushels for the same date in 1933.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending May 4, 1934 amounted to 846,028 bushels, more than half the quantity of the previous week when 1,536,396 bushels were marketed. During the same week in 1933, 2,127,592 bushels were marketed. For the forty weeks ending May 4, 1934 and May 5, 1933, 196,754,313 bushels and 331,716,868 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending May 4, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the same week in 1933: Manitoba 124,987, (194,224) bushels; Saskatchewan 373,462 (941,096) bushels; Alberta 347,579 (992,272) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to May 4, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1932-33 were as follows, figures in brackets being those for 1932-33: Manitoba 25,380,555 (33,663,299) bushels; Saskatchewan 97,078,388 (168,878,949) bushels; Alberta 74,295,370 (129,174,620) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending May 11, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 3,267,288 bushels compared with 1,904,233 bushels for the previous week. During the corresponding week in 1933, 3,880,666 bushels were cleared for overseas ports.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING MAY 11, 1934.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending May 11, 1934 show a net increase of 228,084 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 202,716,938, oats 11,969,557, barley 9,940,996, flaxseed 528,135 and rye 3,899,493 bushels a total of 229,055,119 bushels. Increases were noted in oats of 188,505, barley 268,212, flaxseed 5,738 and rye 6,940 bushels while wheat decreased 241,311 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 211,875,338, oats 10,459,675, barley 6,522,351, flaxseed 1,254,320 and rye 4,967,014 bushels a total of 235,078,698 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks in store show a net decrease of 2,660,603 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 2,428,183, oats 185,744, barley 50,580 and rye 4,052 bushels while flaxseed increased 7,956 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI PUBLIC TERMINALS.- Stocks for the week show a decrease of 57,998 bushels, made up as follows:- wheat 23,228, oats 33,911, barley 809 and flaxseed 50 bushels.

VANCOUVER - NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 45,359 bushels. Decreases are noted in oats of 47,438 and barley 6,899 bushels while wheat increased 7,978 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT, VICTORIA & CHURCHILL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks remain same as the previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Stocks in store show a net decrease of 5,638,755 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 3,667,562, oats 1,499,178, barley 482,983 and flaxseed 7,291 bushels while rye increased 18,259 bushels.

IN TRANSIT LAKES.- Grain in transit shows an increase of 8,278,549 bushels made up as follows:- wheat 6,127,647, oats 1,604,911 and barley 545,991 bushels.
