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WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending June 15, 1934 shows a decrease of 2,752,637 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 197,338,037 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 200,090,674 bushels for the previous week and 192,128,790 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 7,330,896 bushels of which 5,060,733 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 706,058 bushels at New York and 1,540,000 bushels at Erie. This compared with 4,329,616 bushels on the same date last year of which 1,707,209 bushels were located at Buffalo, 948,393 bushels at New York and 1,667,000 bushels at Erie.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2 bushels compared with 4,406,071 bushels last year.

In transit wheat on the lakes amounted to 4,883,052 bushels compared with 3,713,718 bushels for the previous week and 4,961,561 bushels for the corresponding date in 1933.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending June 8, 1934 amounted to 3,714,036 bushels, an increase of 287,332 bushels over the previous week when 3,426,654 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 5,011,522 bushels. For the forty-five weeks ending June 8, 1934 and June 9, 1933, 208,752,936 bushels and 346,901,882 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending June 8, 1934 were as follows figures within brackets being those for the same week in 1933: Manitoba 539,554 (463,393); Saskatchewan 1,971,225 (2,426,634); Alberta 1,203,257 (539,554) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to June 8, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1932-33 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1932-33: Manitoba 26,852,656 (35,505,604) bushels; Saskatchewan 103,110,166 (175,831,772) bushels; Alberta 78,790,114 (135,564,506) bushels.

EXPORTS CLEARANCES

During the week ending June 15, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 3,858,973 bushels compared with 2,309,768 bushels for the previous week, an increase of 1,549,205 bushels.

Oats exported during the ten months ended May, 1934 amounted to 4,568,358 bushels, the bulk, 3,279,021 bushels, went to the United Kingdom while other British Possessions in order of quantity exported were as follows:- Newfoundland 307,812 bushels; British West Indies, consisting of Barbados, Jamaica, Trinidad and other British West Indies, 295,621 bushels; Bermuda 199,240 bushels; British Guiana 50,064 bushels; British Honduras 1,496 bushels, and Straits Settlements 500 bushels; making a total to British Empire countries of 4,133,754 bushels.

Exports of Oats to Foreign countries were 434,604 bushels of which 120,469 bushels were destined to France, 108,234 bushels to Belgium, 98,823 bushels to Netherlands, 46,488 bushels to the United States, 36,896 bushels to Hong Kong, Other Foreign Countries 23,694.

Barley exports amounted to 1,084,998 bushels of which 1,060,808 bushels were exported to the United Kingdom, 10,902 bushels to other Empire Countries, and 13,288 bushels to Foreign Countries.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JUNE 15, 1934.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending June 15, 1934 show a net decrease of 3,095,705 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 197,338,037, oats 10,510,497, barley 9,157,503, flaxseed 505,746 and rye 3,820,738 bushels, a total of 221,332,521 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 2,752,637, oats 216,309, barley 57,196 and rye 74,721 bushels while flaxseed increased 5,158 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 192,128,790, oats 9,662,220, barley 6,354,812, flaxseed 1,003,937 and rye 5,133,678 bushels, a total of 214,283,437 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks of grain show a net increase of 15,154 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 47,182 and flaxseed 750 bushels while decreases are shown in oats of 27,466 barley 3,114 and rye 2,198 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS.— Stocks for the week show a decrease of 117,507 bushels made up as follows:— wheat 45,828, oats 16,041 and barley 55,638 bushels.

VANCOUVER - NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 686,849 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 626,767, and oats 65,360 bushels while barley increased 5,278 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT & CHURCHILL ELEVATORS.— Grain stocks remain same as previous week.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR.—Wheat decreased 333 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).— Grain stocks show a net decrease of 5,951,529 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 5,869,399, barley 47,960 and rye 57,695 bushels while oats and flaxseed increased 20,594 and 2,931 bushels respectively.

IN TRANSIT LAKES.-- Grain in transit shows a net increase of 1,128,824 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 1,169,334 and barley 87,845 bushels while oats decreased 128,355 bushels.




