WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending July 20, 1934 shows a decrease of 1,975,280 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 184,108,612 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 186,083,892 bushels for the previous week and 197,802,896 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 8,972,466 bushels of which 5,974,150 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 1,242,300 bushels at New York, 1,615,000 bushels at Erie and 141,000 bushels at Albany, N.Y. This compared with 6,221,801 bushels on the same date last year of which 3,299,898 bushels were located at Buffalo, 870,847 bushels at New York and 1,994,000 bushels at Erie.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2 bushels compared with 3,752,563 bushels last year.

In transit wheat on the lakes amounted to 2,915,775 bushels compared with 2,739,202 bushels for the previous week and 2,786,577 bushels for the corresponding date in 1933.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending July 13, amounted to 2,885,803 bushels an increase of 62,601 bushels over the previous week when 2,259,792 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 2,967,503 bushels. For the fifty weeks ending July 13, 1934 and July 14, 1933, 222,620,934 bushels and 366,277,650 bushels respectively, were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending July 13, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week of July 14, 1933: Manitoba 326,849 (219,014) bushels; Saskatchewan 1,453,499 (1,346,728) bushels; Alberta 1,105,455 (1,401,761) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to July 13, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1932-33 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1932-33: Manitoba 28,426,228 (38,022,038) bushels; Saskatchewan 108,823,929 (185,028,839) bushels; Alberta 84,370,777 (143,226,773) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES


During the week ending July 20, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 2,493,913 bushels compared with 3,028,702 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 534,789 bushels.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JULY 20, 1934.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending July 20, 1934 shows a net decrease of 2,237,105 bushels. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 184,108,612, oats 10,054,542, barley 8,759,986, flaxseed 439,816 and rye 3,589,700 bushels a total of 206,952,656 bushels. Decreases were noted in wheat of 1,275,280, barley 65,351, flaxseed 5,851 and rye 284,625 bushels while oats increased 94,005 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 197,802,896, oats 11,450,873, barley 7,535,579, flaxseed 984,472 and rye 5,489,995 bushels a total of 223,663,815 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.-- Stocks of grain this week show a decrease of 3,729,473 bushels made up as follows:- wheat 3,389,448, oats 31,263, barley 245,015, flaxseed 16,961 and rye 46,786 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS.-- Stocks for the week show an increase of 85,439 bushels made up of wheat 77,497 and oats 8,942 bushels.


VANCOUVER-NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.-- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 121,971. Decreases are noted in wheat of 128,652 and oats 6,357 bushels while barley increased 13,538 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT & CHURCHILL ELEVATORS.-- Grain stocks remain same as previous week.

INTERIOR ELEVATOR.-- Wheat decreased 100 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).-- Stocks of grain show a net increase of 13,980 bushels. Increases are noted in oats of 163,579, barley 244,880 and flaxseed 15,841 bushels while decreases are shown in wheat and rye of 175,879 and 234,441 bushels respectively.

IN TRANSIT LAKES.-- Grain in transit shows a net increase of 157,008 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 176,573 and oats 84,918 bushels while barley decreased 74,483 bushels.
