WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending September 15, 1933, shows an increase of 4,195,855 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported at 209,438,779 bushels compared with a revised figure of 205,242,924 bushels for the previous week and 153,759,175 bushels for the corresponding week in 1932.

The visible supply is not increasing as rapidly as it did last fall, but 1933 stocks will remain above the stocks on comparable dates of 1932 for some weeks yet.

Canadian wheat in store in the United States amounted to 4,864,583 bushels compared with 7,384,633 bushels on the same date last year.

In transit wheat on the Great Lakes amounted to 5,846,340 bushels on September 15. On September 16, 1932, 7,520,453 bushels were in transit on the lakes.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 3,699,096 bushels compared with 9,592,190 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT OF WHEAT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending September 8 amounted to 10,520,340 bushels, an increase of 1,080,793 bushels compared with those of the previous week when 9,239,547 bushels were marketed. During the same week in 1932, 22,409,580 bushels were reported. For the six weeks ending September 8, 1933, and September 9, 1932, 37,658,302 bushels and 42,099,383 bushels, respectively, were received from the farms.

EXPORT CLEARANCES


During the week ending September 14, 1933, the export clearances amounted to 3,195,239 bushels compared with 3,025,395 bushels for the previous week, an increase of 169,844 bushels. During the corresponding week in 1932, 4,223,876 bushels were cleared for overseas ports.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 15, 1933.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending September 15, 1933 show a net increase of 5,104,360 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in Store were as follows:- wheat 209,438,779, oats 14,528,746, barley 9,877,504, flaxseed 970,501 and rye 5,198,744 bushels, a total of 240,014,274 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 4,195,855, oats 771,257 and barley 471,908 bushels while decreases are shown in flaxseed and rye of 43,073 and 291,587 bushels respectively. For the corresponding week last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 153,759,175, oats 6,94,330, barley 4,521,854, flaxseed 1,268,912 and rye 5,263,024 bushels, a total of 170,907,895 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks in store show a net increase of 2,947,185 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 2,689,397, oats 124,797, barley 198,209 and flaxseed 1,914 bushels while rye decreased 67,132 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS.- Stocks for the week show a net increase of 622,787 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 585,914 and oats 36,888 bushels, while flaxseed decreased 15 bushels.

VANCOUVER AND NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 152,180 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 157,128, barley 815 and rye 2,841 bushels while oats increased 8,604 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS.- Wheat stocks increased 41,877 bushels.

CHURCHILL ELEVATOR.- Stocks in store remain same as previous week.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR.- Wheat stocks increased 610 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Grain stocks increased 2,067,786 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 1,409,704, oats 452,009, barley 255,744 and flaxseed 3,843 bushels, while rye decreased 53,514 bushels.

IN THE GREAT LAKES.- Grain in transit decreased 392,975 bushels. Wheat stocks decreased 401,415 bushels while increases are shown in oats and barley of 3,000 and 5,440 bushels respectively.




