WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending October 12, 1934 shows an increase of 4,453,228 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 234,727,533 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 230,274,305 bushels for the previous week and 242,994,603 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 16,021,584 bushels of which 9,607,796 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 628,821 bushels at New York, 1,977,000 bushels at Erie and 3,147,000 bushels at Albany, N.Y. This compared with 7,140,694 bushels on the same date last year of which 4,645,245 bushels were located at Buffalo, 1,084,068 bushels at New York and 1,393,000 bushels at Erie.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 848,620 bushels compared with 2,795,278 bushels last year.

In transit wheat on the lakes amounted to 3,332,665 bushels compared with 3,336,501 bushels for the previous week and 8,253,596 bushels for the corresponding date in 1933.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending October 5, 1934 amounted to 8,457,256 bushels, an increase over the previous week when 5,308,972 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 14,828,566 bushels. For the ten weeks ending October 5, 1934 and October 6, 1933, 94,203,574 and 93,806,482 bushels respectively were received from the farms. This shows an increase of 397,092 bushels over the same period a year ago. By provinces, the receipts for the week ending October 5, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week ending October 6, 1933: Manitoba 426,484 (1,068,036); Saskatchewan 5,229,569 (7,125,871); Alberta 2,801,203 (6,034,659) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three prairie provinces to October 5, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1933 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1933: Manitoba 21,849,787 (18,829,277); Saskatchewan 45,708,513, (46,653,391); Alberta 26,645,274 (28,323,814) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES


During the week ending October 12, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 2,308,714 bushels compared with 4,199,112 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 1,890,398 bushels.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 12, 1934

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending October 12, 1934 show a net increase of 4,821,387 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 234,727,533, oats 12,781,243, barley 14,291,636, flaxseed 539,044 and rye 4,075,961 bushels a total of 266,415,417 bushels. Increases were noted in wheat of 4,453,228, oats 328,416, barley 44,075 and flaxseed 39,307 bushels while rye decreased 43,639 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 242,994,603, oats 17,864,510, barley 11,620,488, flaxseed 1,062,121 and rye 4,983,496 bushels, a total of 278,530,218 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain in store shows an increase of 3,678,267 bushels, made up as follows:- wheat 3,121,447, oats 458,772, barley 58,895, flaxseed 31,499 and rye 7,647 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS:- Stocks for the week show an increase of 304,106 bushels made up as follows:- wheat 266,113, oats 14,364 and barley 23,629 bushels.

VANCOUVER-NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATOR.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a decrease of 692,695 bushels, made up of wheat 659,244, oats 14,050, barley 19,332 and flaxseed 69 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR.- Wheat stocks decreased 200 bushels.

CHURCHILL ELEVATOR.- Wheat stocks show an increase of 359,356 bushels.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR.- Wheat stocks decreased 333 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Stocks of grain show a net decrease of 1,741,592 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 1,389,122, oats 16,414, and barley 358,632 bushels while increases are shown in flaxseed and rye of 3,135 and 19,441 bushels respectively.

IN TRANSIT LAKES.- Grain in transit shows a net increase of 286,524 bushels. Barley increased 294,350 bushels while decreases are shown in wheat and oats of 3,836 and 4,000 bushels respectively.




