WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending December 14, 1934 shows a slight increase of 1,134,970 bushels as compared with the previous week and an increase of 12,658,633 bushels when compared with the same week in 1933. The visible supply was reported as 256,532,834 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 255,207,864 bushels for the previous week and 243,914,201 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 26,188,446 bushels of which 14,699,087 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 2,468,098 bushels at New York, 2,500,000 bushels at Erie, 4,011,000 bushels at Albany, 1,437,261 bushels at Duluth and 1,013,000 bushels at Chicago. This compared with 15,157,646 bushels on the same date last year of which 6,770,900 bushels were located at Buffalo, 5,881,554 bushels at New York and 1,638,000 bushels at Erie.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 1,048,912 bushels compared with 2,248,845 bushels last year.

In transit wheat on the lakes amounted to 563,890 bushels compared with 1,715,506 bushels for the previous week. Navigation being closed no reports of wheat in transit were reported for 1933.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending December 7, 1934 amounted to 2,983,880 bushels, a decrease of 741,753 bushels from the previous week when 3,725,633 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 3,250,295 bushels. For the nineteen weeks ending December 7, 1934 and December 8, 1933, 164,515,222 and 154,635,464 bushels respectively were received from the farms. This shows an increase of 9,879,758 bushels over the same period a year ago. By provinces the receipts for the week ending December 7, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week ending December 8, 1933: Manitoba 275,585 (173,127); Saskatchewan 1,268,136 (1,681,139); Alberta 1,440,159 (1,396,029) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces to December 7, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1933 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1933: Manitoba 26,339,156 (22,618,419); Saskatchewan 74,535,520 (78,210,359); Alberta 63,640,546 (53,806,686) bushels.

OVERSEAS EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending December 14, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,555,877 bushels as compared with 1,997,915 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 442,038 bushels, but an increase of 173,110 bushels over same week in 1933.

World shipments for the week ending December 17, 1934 amounted to 6,409,000 bushels compared with shipments of 8,322,000 bushels for the previous week and 9,256,000 bushels for the corresponding week last year. Shipments from North America and the Argentine showed decreases of 405,000 and 2,040,000 bushels respectively compared with the previous week while Australian shipments showed an increase of 660,000 bushels during the past week.

During the first twenty weeks of the present crop year world shipments amounted to 205 million bushels compared with 200 million bushels for the corresponding weeks last year. North American shipments were lower than last year while Australian shipments were slightly higher. Since August 1, 1934 the Argentine has cleared 71 million bushels of wheat compared with 35 million bushels for the same period in 1933.

Weekly Average Shipments

The following table shows weekly average shipments of wheat for the first twenty weeks of the present crop year along with comparative figures for 1933-34 and 1932-33.

As shown by the above table, world shipments of wheat have averaged 10.2 million bushels per week during the first twenty weeks of the crop year as compared with 10.0 and 11.1 million bushels per week during the corresponding period in 1933-34 and 1932-33. North American shipments have averaged 3.7 million bushels per week compared with 4.7 and 7.2 million bushels per week during the first twenty weeks of 1933-34 and 1932-33. Argentine shipments have averaged 3.5 million bushels per week as compared with 1.8 million bushels during the same period last year.

Exports via Shipping Routes

Wheat Exports Month of November, 1934.

According to Canadian Customs returns 18,769,770 bushels of wheat valued at \$14,744,938 were exported from Canada during the month of November, 1934. This compared with 23,143,958 bushels valued at \$15,298,768 for the same month in 1933. The routing of the exports during November, 1934 shows 1,888,318 bushels were exported to the United States for consumption against 124 bushels for the same month in 1933. The movement via United States Atlantic ports for export overseas amounted to 6,220,270 bushels. The balance amounting to 10,661,182 bushels were exported from Canadian sea-board ports as follows: 6,445,036 bushels from Canadian Atlantic ports, 4,216,146 bushels from Canadian Pacific ports.

The amount re-routed from United States Lake ports during the month was 55,100 bushels, which increased the movement to Canadian ports to 10,716,282 bushels and decreased the export via United States ports to 6,165,170 bushels.

Wheat Exports - Four Months November, 1934.

Exports of wheat during the four months ending November, 1934 amounted to 72,875,588 bushels valued at \$61,031,869 compared with 75,074,789 bushels with a value of \$52,715,279. Of the former amount 6,062,328 bushels were exported to the United States for consumption. This is considerably in advance of the same period last year when only 99,645 bushels were exported to United States^x. The quantity exported to United States for export overseas was 27,075,062 bushels, against 21,460,457 bushels for the corresponding period in 1933. The movement via Canadian Atlantic ports amounted to 19,986,476 bushels, Pacific ports 15,701,851 bushels and 4,049,871 bushels from Churchill making a total export via Canadian ports of 39,738,198 bushels.

The re-routed wheat from United States Lake ports to Canadian ports amounted to 747,099 bushels which increased the movement via Canadian ports to 40,485,297 bushels and decreased the exports via United States ports to 26,327,963 bushels.

Wheatflour Exports - Month of November, 1934.

During the month of November, 1934, 11,883 barrels of wheatflour were exported to United States direct for consumption, 62,076 barrels moved via United States ports for export overseas, 362,359 barrels were exported via Canadian Atlantic ports, 68,066 barrels via Pacific ports. The total export for the month amounted to 504,384 barrels valued at \$1,982,803 compared with 547,602 barrels valued at \$1,882,856 during the same month in 1933.

Wheatflour Exports - Four Months ending November, 1934.

Wheatflour exports during the four months ending November, 1934 show a decrease from the same period in 1933. The number of barrels exported for the four months period in 1934 was 1,771,342 barrels valued at \$6,928,022 compared with 2,094,814 barrels valued at \$7,853,964 for the same four months in 1933, a decrease in quantity of 323,472 barrels but an increase in value of \$925,942.

Exports via Canadian Atlantic ports amounted to 1,269,924 barrels, via Canadian Pacific Ports 312,293 barrels and 14,643 barrels via Churchill while 157,075 barrels were exported to the United States ports for export overseas and 17,407 barrels were shipped to the United States for consumption.

Wheat and Wheatflour - Exports combined for the month of November, 1934.

The combined exports of wheat and wheatflour, (the latter reduced to bushels at $4\frac{1}{2}$ to the barrel) amounted to 21,039,498 bushels compared with 25,608,167 bushels for the same month in 1933. Of the former amount 1,941,792 bushels went to the United States for consumption, 6,499,612 bushels were exported to the United States for export overseas, 4,522,443 bushels were moved direct from Canadian Atlantic ports, 8,075,651 bushels were shipped overseas from the Canadian Pacific ports, making a total via Canadian Ports of 12,598,094 bushels.

^xThe increased movement to the United States for consumption is due to the large amounts of wheat imported from Canada into the United States for livestock feeding purposes on which a duty of 10 per cent ad valorem is collected.

Re-routed wheat from United States Lake ports during the month of November, 1934, amounted to 55,100 bushels, which increased the movement to Canadian ports to 12,653,194 bushels and decreased the export via United States ports to 6,554,712 bushels.

Wheat and Wheatflour - Four months ending November, 1934.

Exports of wheat and wheatflour in bushels for the four months ending November, 1934 and 1933 amounted to 80,846,628 and 84,501,452 bushels respectively. The routing of the first amount was as follows:- 6,140,661 bushels moved into the United States direct, 27,781,898 bushels were shipped to the United States for export overseas, 25,701,134 bushels were exported direct from Canadian Atlantic ports, 17,107,170 bushels were shipped from Canadian Pacific ports and 4,115,765 bushels moved from Churchill, Manitoba, a total of 46,924,069 bushels, via Canadian ports.

The re-routed wheat amounted to 747,099 bushels which increased the Canadian exports to 47,671,168 bushels and decreased the amount routed via United States ports to 27,034,792 bushels.

Coarse Grain Exports

Oats

Oats exported during the month of November, 1934 amounted to 1,674,314 bushels compared with 595,580 bushels for the same month in 1933. An outstanding feature this year is the comparative heavy export to the United States for consumption. For the month the export was 838,224 bushels compared with 9,457 bushels for the same month in 1933. There were no exports via United States ports for overseas consumption. 362,274 bushels moved via Canadian Atlantic ports and 473,816 bushels from Pacific ports to overseas destinations. For the four months ending November, 1934, 5,464,942 bushels were exported compared with 1,320,141 bushels for the same period a year ago. Exports to the United States for consumption amounted to 2,108,666 bushels during the above four months in 1934. During the same period a year ago only 32,764 bushels were so exported. Only 4,010 bushels of the 1934 export moved via United States ports for overseas ports, 1,872,548 bushels moved from Canadian Atlantic ports, and 1,475,642 bushels from Pacific ports. Exports via Churchill were 4,076 bushels.

Barley

Barley exports amounted to 2,919,379 bushels for the month of November, 1934, compared with 169,910 bushels for the same month a year ago. Of the former amount 2,038,044 bushels went into the United States for consumption, while none was shown so exported for the same month a year ago. Direct exports from Canadian Atlantic and Pacific ports were 822,251 and 59,084 bushels respectively. During the four months ending November, 1934, 7,903,756 bushels were exported, compared with 426,080 bushels for the same period in 1933. Of the 7,903,756 bushels exported 4,873,845 bushels moved to United States for consumption, while none was shown as exported for the same period a year ago. This large movement to the United States is due to the demand from United States importers for Canadian barley for feeding and malting purposes. Some 132,273 bushels went via United States ports overseas. Canadian exports from Atlantic and Pacific ports amounted to 2,608,374 and 289,264 bushels respectively.

Rye

Rye exports during the month of November, 1934 amounted to only 38,551 bushels while 351,540 bushels were exported for the same month in 1933. During the four months ending November, 1934, 623,322 bushels were exported, the bulk of which was shipped to the United States, the amount being 541,881 bushels, while some 81,441 bushels were shipped to overseas countries via Canadian Atlantic and Pacific ports.

Flaxseed

Flaxseed, exported for the month of November, amounted to only 1 bushel from Canadian Atlantic ports to overseas countries. The four months exports amounted to 2,443 bushels, 38 bushels going to the United States direct, 2,405 bushels to Atlantic ports.

United States Imports of Canadian Wheat

Imports of wheat from Canada into United States for milling in bond for the period from August 4, 1933 to December 8, 1934 amounted to 4,187,000 bushels which added to the 45,226,864 bushels cleared from Canadian and United States seaboard according to Canadian elevators and United States Customs returns makes a total of 59,621,274 bushels. According to United States Customs returns 5,046,000 bushels of Canadian wheat was imported duty paid into the United States for consumption since the beginning of the crop year.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING DECEMBER 14, 1934.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending December 14, 1934 show a net increase of 1,157,098 bushels as compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 256,532,834, oats 16,155,396, barley 11,618,229 flaxseed 467,778 and rye 3,971,312 bushels, a total of 288,745,549 bushels. Decreases were noted in barley of 112,628, flaxseed 98,250 and rye 1,613 bushels while increases were shown in wheat of 1,322,970 and oats 46,619 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 243,914,201, oats 20,137,103, barley 11,816,259, flaxseed 621,596 and rye 4,128,702 bushels a total of 280,617,861 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain in store shows a net increase of 1,666,580 bushels. Rye decreased 1,489 bushels while increases were shown in wheat of 1,618,798, oats 29,866 barley 17,278 and flaxseed 2,127 bushels.

EASTERN ELEVATORS - LAKE PORTS:- Grain stocks for the week show a net decrease of 609,234 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 777,627, flaxseed 1,536 and rye 2,663 bushels while increases are shown in oats and barley 170,069 and 2,523 bushels respectively.




