WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending January 11, 1935 shows a slight decrease of 796,791 bushels as compared with the previous week and an increase of 19,982,314 bushels when compared with the same week in 1934. The visible supply was reported as 256,927,469 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 257,724,260 bushels for the previous week and 236,945,155 bushels for the corresponding week in 1934.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 26,838,989 bushels of which 15,358,565 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 2,019,050 bushels at New York, 2,454,000 bushels at Erie, 4,139,000 bushels at Albany, 1,739,374 bushels at Duluth and 786,000 bushels at Chicago. This compared with 11,711,703 bushels on the same date last year of which 4,073,075 bushels were located at Buffalo, 5,442,631 bushels at New York and 594,000 bushels at Erie.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 1,048,912 bushels compared with 2,248,845 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending January 4, 1935 amounted to 830,090 bushels, slightly over half the previous week, when 1,658,000 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week as year ago the receipts were 1,493,297 bushels. For the twenty-three weeks ending January 4, 1935 and January 5, 1934, 174,615,473 and 162,306,901 bushels respectively were received from the farms. This is an increase of 12,308,572 bushels over the same period a year ago. By provinces the receipts for the week ending January 4, 1935 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week ending January 5, 1934: Manitoba 53,294 (104,137); Saskatchewan 281,846 (731,131); Alberta 494,950 (658,029) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces to January 4, 1935 as compared with the same period in 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1934: Manitoba 26,740,829 (22,963,479); Saskatchewan 77,632,033 (81,743,849); Alberta 70,242,611 (57,599,573) bushels.

OVERSEAS EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending January 11, 1935 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,637,394 bushels as compared with 1,174,848 bushels for the previous week, an increase of 462,546 bushels, and a decrease of 995,634 bushels compared with the same week in 1934.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JANUARY 11, 1935.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending January 11, 1935 show a net decrease of 801,506 bushels, compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 256,927,469, oats 16,949,851, barley 13,088,505, flaxseed 429,536 and rye 3,792,639 bushels a total of 291,188,000 bushels. Decreases were noted in wheat of 796,791, barley 7,305, flaxseed 10,155 and rye 140,873 bushels while oats increased 153,618 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 236,945,155, oats 19,632,697, barley 11,367,829, flaxseed 601,186 and rye 4,085,911 bushels, a total of 272,632,778 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain in store shows a net decrease of 649 bushels. Barley decreased 37,567 bushels while increases are noted in wheat of 4,788, oats 30,133, flaxseed 1,084 and rye 913 bushels.






