WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending February 15, 1935 shows a decrease of 96,237 bushels as compared with the previous week and an increase of 11,492,983 bushels when compared with the same week in 1934. The visible supply was reported as 244,173,989 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 244,270,226 bushels for the previous week and 232,681,006 bushels for the corresponding week in 1934.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 23,424,868 bushels of which 12,915,321 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 1,172,173 bushels at New York, 2,123,000 bushels at Erie, 4,139,000 bushels at Albany, 1,714,374 bushels at Duluth and 786,000 bushels at Chicago. A new port is added to the above list this week, New Orleans with 292,000 bushels. This compared with 8,593,159 bushels on the same date last year of which 3,722,001 bushels were located at Buffalo, 3,629,183 bushels at New York and 894,121 bushels at Boston.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 1,048,912 bushels compared with 2,248,845 bushels last year.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending February 8, 1935 amounted to 1,745,096 bushels, an increase of 706,910 bushels over the previous week when 1,038,186 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding period a year ago the receipts were 2,081,402 bushels. For the twenty-eight weeks ending February 8, 1935 and February 9, 1934, 179,829,927 bushels and 174,121,554 bushels respectively were received from the farms. This is an increase of 5,708,373 bushels over the same period a year ago. By provinces the receipts for the week ending February 8, 1935 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week ending February 9, 1934: Manitoba 92,000 (118,961); Saskatchewan 693,921 (935,679); Alberta 959,175 (1,026,762) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces to February 8, 1935 as compared with the same period in 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1934: Manitoba 27,028,614 (23,456,119); Saskatchewan 79,568,535 (86,600,403); Alberta 73,232,778 (64,065,032) bushels.

OVERSEAS EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending February 15, 1935 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,207,504 bushels as compared with 2,209,360 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 1,001,856, and a decrease of 805,863 bushels compared with the same week in 1934.

World shipments for the week ending February 18, 1935 amounted to 10,103,000 bushels compared with shipments of 11,052,000 bushels for the previous week and 10,568,000 bushels for the corresponding week last year. During the past week North American and Australian shipments showed decreases of 803,000 and 540,000 bushels respectively. Shipments from the Argentine also decreased slightly.

During the first twenty-nine weeks of the present crop year world shipments amounted to 292 million bushels compared with 299 million bushels for the corresponding weeks last year. North American shipments were lower than last year while Australian shipments were slightly higher. Since August 1, 1934 the Argentine has cleared 103 million bushels of wheat compared with 62 million bushels for the same period in 1933-34.

Weekly Average Shipments

The following table shows weekly average shipments of wheat for the first twenty-nine weeks of the present crop year along with comparative figures for 1933-34 and 1932-33.

As shown by the above table, world shipments of wheat have averaged 10.1 million bushels per week during the first twenty-nine weeks of the crop year as compared with 10.3 and 12.0 million bushels per week during the corresponding period in 1933-34 and 1932-33. North American shipments have averaged 3.3 million bushels per week compared with 4.5 and 6.5 million bushels per week during the first twenty-nine weeks of 1933-34 and 1932-33. Argentine shipments have averaged 3.5 million bushels per week as compared with 2.1 million bushels during the same period last year.

GENERAL INDEX

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 15, 1935.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending February 15, 1935 show a net decrease of 30,539 bushels, compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 244,173,989, oats 15,239,320, barley 12,212,204, flaxseed 412,431 and rye 3,913,674 bushels, a total of 275,951,618 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 96,237, barley 31,699, flaxseed 4,077 and rye 11,122 bushels while oats increased 112,596 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 232,681,006, oats 19,108,292, barley 10,893,640, flaxseed 600,133 and rye 4,053,728 bushels, a total of 267,336,799 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Grain in store this week shows a net decrease of 41,303 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 19,370, barley 49,798, flaxseed 8,462 and rye 9,814 bushels while oats increased 46,141 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS.- Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 143,548 bushels. Wheat decreased 156,908 bushels while oats and flaxseed increased 10,802 and 2,558 bushels respectively.

VANCOUVER-NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show an increase of 1,171,703 bushels, made up as follows:- wheat 1,034,023, oats 102,574 and barley 35,106 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR.- Grain stocks show an increase of 175,829 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 175,742 and oats 87 bushels.

VICTORIA AND CHURCHILL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks remain unchanged.






