WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending April 12, 1935 shows a decrease of 2,550,026 bushels as compared with the previous week and an increase of 7,312,931 bushels when compared with the same week in 1934. The visible supply was reported as 227,202,133 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 229,752,159 bushels for the previous week and 219,889,202 bushels for the corresponding week in 1934.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 14,407,472 bushels, a decrease of 772,224 bushels from the previous week when 15,179,696 bushels were reported. The Canadian wheat in store in the United States is located at the following ports: Buffalo 7,335,543; New York 599,159; Erie 1,005,000; Albany 3,936,000; Duluth 1,341,770; and New Orleans 190,000. Decreases took place in the stock in all the United States ports, and were as follows: Buffalo 389,875; New York 213,092; Albany 73,000; Duluth 25,257; Erie 65,000 and New Orleans 6,000 bushels. For the corresponding week a year ago Canadian wheat stocks in United States positions amounted to 3,817,633 bushels located as follows: Buffalo 426,004; New York 1,667,362; Boston 220,468; Albany 1,498,000 and Duluth 5,799 bushels.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 1,048,912 bushels as compared with 2,228,643 bushels a year ago.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending April 5, 1935 amounted to 1,786,487 bushels, an increase of 24,153 bushels over the previous week when 1,762,334 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding period a year ago the receipts were 2,173,112 bushels. For the thirty-five weeks ending April 5, 1935 and April 6, 1934, 196,351,919 and 190,656,416 bushels were received from the farms. This is an increase of 5,695,503 bushels over the same period a year ago. By provinces the receipts for the week ending April 5, 1935 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week ending April 6, 1934: Manitoba 144,466 (247,400); Saskatchewan 795,714 (1,107,564); Alberta 846,307 (818,148) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces to April 5, 1935 as compared with the same period in 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1934: Manitoba 28,330,042 (24,873,944); Saskatchewan 86,137,709 (94,088,628); Alberta 81,730,158 (71,693,844) bushels.

OVERSEAS EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending April 12, 1935 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 2,371,468 bushels as compared with 1,750,100 bushels for the previous week, an increase of 621,368 bushels and when compared with the same week in 1934 an increase of 114,730 bushels.



CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING APRIL 12, 1935.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending April 12, 1935 show a decrease of 3,559,406 bushels, compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 227,202,133, oats 13,179,173, barley 9,725,563, flaxseed 408,280 and rye 3,782,862 bushels, a total of 254,298,016 bushels. Decreases were noted in wheat of 2,550,026, oats 397,341, barley 596,716, flaxseed 4,295 and rye 11,028 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 219,889,202, oats 15,052,665, barley 10,342,552, flaxseed 554,700 and rye 3,982,823 bushels, a total of 249,821,942 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain in store this week shows a decrease of 1,756,303 bushels composed of wheat 1,482,032, oats 227,649, barley 28,756, flaxseed 6,233 and rye 11,633 bushels.
