WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending August 31, 1934 shows an increase of 8,534,469 bushels as compared with the previous week. The visible supply was reported as 193,771,008 bushels as compared with a revised figure of 185,236,539 bushels for the previous week and 198,952,331 bushels for the corresponding week in 1933.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 10,065,306 bushels of which 4,601,529 bushels were in store at Buffalo, 1,520,491 bushels at New York, 1,615,000 bushels at Eric and 2,236,000 bushels at Albany, N.Y. This compared with 4,784,542 bushels on the same date last year of which 2,089,729 bushels were located at Buffalo, 659,548 bushels at New York and 1,983,000 bushels at Eric.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2 bushels compared with 3,672,318 bushels last year.

In transit wheat on the lakes amounted to 2,458,518 bushels compared with 1,703,504 bushels for the previous week and 4,270,000 bushels for the corresponding date in 1933.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending August 24, 1934 amounted to 9,020,987 bushels, three times the amount of the previous week, when 3,002,817 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 11,032,622 bushels. For the four weeks ending August 24, 1934 and August 25, 1933, 15,035,721 bushels and 17,898,415 bushels respectively were received from the farms. By provinces the receipts for the week ending August 24, 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week ending August 25, 1933, Manitoba 2,954,531 (4,865,097) bushels; Saskatchewan 3,735,045 (4,795,312) bushels; Alberta 2,331,411 (1,392,213) bushels.

Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces up to August 24, 1934 as compared with the same period in 1933-34 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1933-34: Manitoba 5,587,867 (7,655,774) bushels; Saskatchewan 5,567,877 (6,190,858) bushels; Alberta 5,879,977 (4,051,783) bushels.

EXPORT CLEARANCES


During the week ending August 31, 1934 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 3,676,079 bushels compared with 2,984,527 bushels for the previous week, an increase of 691,552 bushels.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING AUGUST 31, 1934.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 31, 1934 show a net increase of 9,557,241 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 193,771,008, oats 10,679,957, barley 9,822,567, flaxseed 458,057 and rye 4,076,517 bushels, a total of 218,808,106 bushels. Increases were shown in wheat of 8,534,469, oats 34,746, barley 829,549 and rye 159,823 bushels, while flaxseed decreased 1,346 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 198,952,331, oats 13,500,910, barley 8,917,351, flaxseed 1,013,389 and rye 5,463,539 bushels, a total of 227,847,520 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS: - Stocks of grain this week show an increase of 6,807,576 bushels, made up as follows:- wheat 6,261,382, oats 97,959, barley 381,628, flaxseed 2,727 and rye 63,880 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS. Stocks for the week show a net increase of 706 bushels. Wheat increased 22,550 bushels while oats decreased 21,944 bushels.

VANCOUVER - NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS... Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 1,247,410 bushels. Increases were noted in wheat of 1,138,756, oats 88,518, barley 18,523 and rye 1,716 bushels, while flaxseed decreased 103 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR.- Stocks of grain show a net increase of 2,663 bushels. Wheat increased 2,966 bushels while oats decreased 303 bushels.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR.- Grain stocks remain unchanged; Churchill Elevator:- Wheat stocks show a decrease of 240,510 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Stocks this week show a net increase of 337,788 bushels. Increases were noted in wheat of 855,477, barley 72,648, flaxseed 595 and rye 97,244 bushels while oats decreased 688,176 bushels.

IN TRANSIT LAKES - Grain in transit shows an increase of 1,525,355 bushels made up as follows:- wheat 755,014, oats 695,332 and barley 75,009 bushels.


