WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending July 12 shows a decrease of 1,831,279 bushels as compared with the previous week and an increase of 8,960,506 bushels when compared with the same week in 1934. The visible supply was reported as 195,044,398 bushels as compared with the revised figure of 196,875,677 bushels for the previous week and 186,083,892 bushels for the corresponding week in 1934.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 8,265,689 bushels, a net decrease of 346,757 bushels from the previous week when 8,612,446 bushels were reported. The Canadian wheat in store in the United States is located at the following ports: Buffalo 3,381,040; New York 885,008; Albany 2,595,000; Erie 344,000; Duluth 668,641; Galveston 345,000 and New Orleans 47,000 bushels. Decreases in stocks as compared with the previous week were as follows: Buffalo 161,026; New York 14,731; Erie 111,000; Galveston 54,000 and New Orleans 6,000 bushels. The stocks at Albany and Duluth remain unchanged. For the corresponding week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 9,135,030 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 6,096,894; New York 1,282,136; Albany 141,000 and Erie 1,615,000 bushels.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2 bushels compared with the same amount at the corresponding date a year ago.

Wheat in transit on the Lakes is reported as 1,468,036 bushels compared with 1,118,689 bushels for the previous week.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending July 5, amounted to 2,731,733 bushels, an increase of 261,363 bushels from the previous week's total when 2,470,370 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding period a year ago the receipts were 2,259,792 bushels. For the forty-nine weeks ending July 5, 1935 and July 6, 1934, 218,713,610 and 218,735,131 bushels were received from the farms. This is a decrease of 21,521 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending July 5, 1935 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for the week ending July 6, 1934: Manitoba 258,453 (345,407); Saskatchewan 1,344,934 (951,280); Alberta 1,128,346 (963,105) bushels.


Marketings of wheat in the three Prairie Provinces to July 5, 1935 as compared with the same period in 1934 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1934: Manitoba 30,964,446 (28,099,379); Saskatchewan 96,837,228 (107,370,430); Alberta 90,911,936 (83,265,322) bushels.

OVERSEAS EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending July 12, 1935 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,102,239 bushels as compared with 1,442,503 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 340,264 and when compared with the same week in 1934 a decrease of 1,926,463 bushels.

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JULY 12, 1935.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending July 12, 1935 show a net decrease of 2,967,300 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows:- Wheat 195,044,398, oats 4,912,071, barley 4,487,350, flaxseed 310,500 and rye 3,062,170 bushels, a total of 207,816,989 bushels. Decreases were noted in wheat of 1,831,279, oats 532,683, barley 384,179 and rye 233,377 bushels while flaxseed increased 14,218 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows:- wheat 186,083,892, oats 9,960,537, barley 8,825,337, flaxseed 445,667 and rye 3,874,328 bushels, a total of 209,189,761 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks show a net decrease of 3,911,027 bushels. Decreases were noted in wheat of 3,474,615, oats 352,347, barley 67,933 and rye 17,130 bushels while flaxseed increased 998 bushels.

INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS.- Stocks for the week show a decrease of 78,468 bushels, composed of wheat 46,124, oats 30,946 and barley 1,398 bushels.

VANCOUVER-NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 309,725 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 259,830, oats 35,917, barley 13,713 and rye 294 bushels while flaxseed increased 29 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT AND CHURCHILL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks remain unchanged.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR.- Wheat stocks show a decrease of 109 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Grain in store shows a net increase of 1,567,522 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 1,910,537, oats 28,709 and flaxseed 9,243 bushels while decreases are shown in barley and rye 192,167 and 188,800 bushels respectively.

IN TRANSIT LAKES.- Grain in transit shows an increase of 649,648 bushels, composed of wheat 349,347, oats 54,780 and barley 245,521 bushels.


