WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending August 16, shows an increase of 2,298,672 bushels as compared with the previous week and an increase of 10,974,288 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1934. The visible supply was reported as 195,900,313 bushels as compared with the revised figure of 193,601,641 bushels for the previous week and 184,925,025 bushels for the week ending August 17, 1934.

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 17,890,139 bushels a net increase of 5,883,632 bushels over the previous week when 12,006,507 bushels were reported. The Canadian wheat in store in the United States is located at the following ports: Buffalo 14,987,286; New York 659,746; Albany 1,399,000; Erie 27,000; New Orleans 21,000; Duluth 543,107; and Galveston 253,000 bushels. Buffalo and Duluth stocks show increases of 5,614,188 and 72,410 bushels respectively over those of the previous week. Galveston received 253,000 bushels as no wheat was reported at that port during the past two weeks. Decreases are noted in the stocks at Albany of 55,000 bushels and New York of 966 bushels. Erie and New Orleans stocks remained the same as those of the previous week. For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 10,386,124 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 5,027,673; Erie 1,615,000; Duluth 99,911; New York 1,776,540; and Albany 1,867,000 bushels.

United States wheat in Canada was shown as 2 bushels compared with the same amount at the corresponding date a year ago.

Wheat in transit on the lakes is reported as 7,029,233 bushels compared with 6,958,157 bushels for the previous week.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat marketings in the Prairie Provinces for the period ending August 9, amounted to 1,444,683 bushels a decrease of 1,171,858 bushels over the previous week's total when 2,616,541 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding period a year ago the receipts were 1,509,147 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the period ending August 9, 1935 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1934: Manitoba 69,727 (134,025); Saskatchewan 558,871 (387,647); Alberta 816,085 (987,475) bushels.

OVERSEAS EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending August 16, 1935 the export clearances of wheat amounted to 1,568,097 bushels as compared with 1,597,326 bushels for the previous week, a decrease of 29,229 and when compared with the same week in 1934 a decrease of 1,460,775 bushels.



World shipments for the week ending August 19, 1935 amounted to 6,466,000 bushels as compared with shipments of 6,345,000 bushels for the previous week and 10,664,000 bushels for the corresponding week last year. North American shipments showed an increase of 1,046,000 bushels as compared with the previous week, while shipments from the Argentine showed a decrease of 1,629,000 bushels.

During the first three weeks of the present crop year world shipments amounted to 19 million bushels as compared with 33 million bushels for the corresponding weeks last year. North American shipments amounted to only 7 million bushels this year as compared with 13 million bushels in 1934-35.



CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING August 16, 1935.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 16, 1935 show a net increase of 2,156,904 bushels compared with the revised figure of the previous week. Stocks in store were as follows: wheat 195,900,313, oats 5,786,029, barley 3,085,793, flaxseed 280,980 and rye 3,046,005 bushels, a total of 208,099,120 bushels. Increases were noted in wheat of 2,298,672 and rye 118,508 bushels while decreases were shown in oats of 56,234, barley 195,890 and flaxseed 8,152 bushels. At a comparable date last year stocks in store were as follows: wheat 184,926,025, oats 10,541,333, barley 8,356,946, flaxseed 456,395 and rye 3,822,688 bushels, a total of 208,103,388 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain in store shows a net decrease of 1,135,403 bushels. Decreases were noted in wheat of 1,224,763 and flaxseed 562 bushels while increases are shown in oats of 31,231, barley 20,351 and rye 38,340 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the prairie Provinces on August 9, 1935 with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1934.


INTERIOR PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC TERMINALS. - Stocks for the week show a net increase of 161,230 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 161,305 and oats 456 bushels while flaxseed decreased 531 bushels.

VANCOUVER-NEW WESTMINSTER ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 140,271 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 137,886 and oats 3,827 bushels, while barley increased 1,442 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT, VICTORIA AND CHURCHILL ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks remain unchanged.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR). - Grain in store shows a net decrease of 7,275,879 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 7,233,480, oats 73,066 and barley 50,039 bushels while flaxseed and rye increased 913 and 79,793 bushels respectively.

IN TRANSIT LAKES:- Grain in transit shows a net increase of 30,678 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat of 71,126, and oats 84,555 bushels while decreases are shown in barley and flaxseed of 53,005 and 72,000 bushels respectively.




