CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - Week ending January 28th, 1921.

GRAIN STOCKS IN ELEVATORS.

According to returns received at the dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending January 28th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased by 2,199,282 bushels in wheat, barley and rye as compared with the previous week. Decreases are shown of 2,071,894; 88,776 and 38,612 bushels respectively in the foregoing grains. Oats indicates an increase of 1,418,978 bushels and flax, 92,811 bushels. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 1,525,612 bushels, and barley, 112,631 bushels. Oats shows an increase of 752,792 bushels and flax, 18,063 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 289,567 bushels; oats, 232,989 bushels; flax, 236 bushels and rye, 796 bushels. Barley indicates a decrease of 4,094 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur an increase is shown in oats of 602,298 bushels; barley, 19,943 bushels and flax, 59,402 bushels. Wheat indicates a decrease of 120,036 bushels and rye, 6,007 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 167,339 bushels; oats, 105,313 bushels and flax, 15,110 bushels. Barley shows a decrease of 6,589 bushels and rye, 1,493 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East the quantity of grain in store has decreased by 637,433 bushels in wheat and oats. Decreases are shown of 565,019 and 274,414 bushels respectively. Barley shows an increase of 14,595 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports a decrease is shown in wheat of 520,433 bushels and rye, 31,908 bushels.

The inspections for the week ending January 21st, 1921 show 3,529 cars as compared with 4,088 of the previous week.
