GRAIN STOCKS IN ELEVATORS

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending January 7th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased by 4,577,395 bushels in wheat, barley, flax and rye as compared with the previous week. Decreases are shown of 2,946,623; 1,257,198; 185,268 and 188,306 bushels respectively in the foregoing grains. Oats indicates an increase of 49,696 bushels. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 3,734,142 bushels; oats, 473,710 bushels; barley, 1,293,405 bushels and flax, 266,950 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 70,694 bushels; oats, 76,873 bushels; barley, 244 bushels and flax, 1,166 bushels. Rye indicates a decrease of 857 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur the quantity of grain in store has increased by 899,671 bushels in wheat; oats, 354,180 bushels; barley, 104,327 bushels; flax, 73,549 bushels and rye, 26,511 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators wheat shows an increase of 71,518 bushels; barley, 10,023 bushels and flax, 15,538 bushels. Oats indicates a decrease of 9,658 bushels and rye, 2,934 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East the quantity of grain in store has decreased by 630,647 bushels in wheat, barley, flax and rye. Decreases are shown of 348,192; 53,122; 8,571 and 220,762 bushels respectively. Oats shows an increase of 102,011 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports wheat indicates an increase of 93,828 bushels and rye, 9,736 bushels. Barley indicates a decrease of 25,265 bushels.

The inspections for the week ending January 7th, 1921, show 3,790 cars as compared with 6,188 of the previous week.
