GRAIN STOCKS IN ELEVATORS.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending February 11th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has increased by 1,346,565 bushels in Oats, Barley and Flax, as compared with the previous week. Increases are shown of 1,098,220; 199,472 and 48,873 bushels respectively in the foregoing grains. Wheat indicates a decrease of 1,259,480 bushels and rye, 38,731 bushels. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 1,087,878 bushels and flax, 26,479 bushels. Oats indicates an increase of 470,654 bushels and barley, 52,446 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 182,726 bushels; oats, 147,295 bushels and flax, 1,016 bushels. Barley shows a decrease of 4,984 bushels and rye, 1,634 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 88,491 bushels; Oats, 516,808 bushels; barley, 139,157 bushels; and flax, 53,747 bushels. Rye indicates a decrease of 51,613 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 195,478 bushels; oats, 143,927 bushels; barley, 2,721 bushels and flax, 20,589 bushels. Rye indicates a decrease of 2,925 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East the quantity of grain in store has decreased in wheat of 425,370 bushels and oats, 180,464 bushels. Barley indicates an increase of 10,132 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports wheat indicates a decrease of 212,927 bushels; while rye indicates an increase of 17,471 bushels.

The inspections for the week ending February 7th, 1921 show 3,433 cars as compared with 5,664 of the previous week.
