INTERNAL TRADE DIVISION.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending March 18th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has increased by 1,492,806 bushels in oats; barley 285,007 bushels; flax, 5,665 bushels and rye, 19,053 bushels. Wheat indicates a decrease of 569,209 bushels, as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators an increase is shown in oats of 398,068 bushels and barley, 79,613 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 217,808 bushels and flax, 8,895 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 132,574 bushels; oats, 363,707 bushels; barley, 4,226 bushels and flax, 2,397 bushels. Rye indicates a decrease of 510 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur an increase is shown in wheat of 318,733 bushels; oats, 783,565 bushels; barley, 228,536 bushels; flax, 6,791 bushels and rye, 32,422 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 48,559 bushels; oats, 38,234 bushels and flax, 5,372 bushels; while barley indicates a decrease of 4,290 bushels and rye, 1,110 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East the quantity of grain in store has decreased by 813,810 bushels in wheat; oats, 90,568 bushels and barley, 23,078 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports a decrease is shown in wheat of 37,457 bushels and rye, 11,749 bushels.

The inspections for the week ending March 14th, 1921, show 3,399 cars as compared with 3,429 of the previous week.
